Accepted	<p>There is now a system in place whereby a discharge/transfer list is provided from the Offender Management Unit to all Healthcare Managers on a weekly/daily basis, it sets out the medication requirements for prisoners. The GP will then prescribe 7 days' worth of medication for discharge/transfer prisoners. In situations where there is very little time for the GP to prescribe the medication the supply on the wing will be used.</p> <p>Given the current position with COVID 19 as a temporary measure, prisoners are being supplied with 14 days' medication.</p>	<p>Complete</p> <p>Head of Healthcare</p>
