1	The GP Lead at HMP Exeter should review prescribing processes to ensure high-risk medication assessments are completed in a timely way, with consideration of the impact on the individual.	Accepted	The process of medication reconciliation for previous prescriptions, recreational or any over the counter medications has been completed by the prison pharmacy team. This information alongside their own assessment of the patient's needs, history, and presentation will be used by the General Practitioner (GP) to issue any prescriptions. The GP must set a review period of any high-risk, and new medications. In the event that the GP, did not prescribe the current medication the patient is on, in accordance with RCGP2019 (guidance for prescribers for use in prison settings) the GP will suggest an alternative. The impact on the individual will remain at the centre of any decisions made and will be discussed in medication management meetings, which is now scheduled quarterly. Attendees will include the GP, pharmacy and site representatives, usually the head of healthcare or deputy head of healthcare and key prescribers.
