1	<p>The Governor and Head of Healthcare should ensure that in line with Prison Service Instruction (PSI) 64/2011:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Staff are aware that the ACCT plan should travel with the prisoner when he leaves his wing, including when he participates in activities; and • When ACCT monitoring is started, healthcare staff assess a prisoner's risk to determine whether he should continue to keep and administer prescribed medication. 	Accepted	<p>ACCT training provides guidance on the effective management of the ACCT process and is delivered to all new staff and as refresher training. This includes the importance of all staff being aware that the ACCT document should travel with the prisoner to all activities. It is the responsibility of the unit Supervising Officer (SO) to ensure that open ACCTs follow prisoners to all locations off the wing and all SOs have been reminded of this at morning briefings.</p> <p>The ACCT training also includes instructions to staff completing the immediate action plan to document whether healthcare feel it is appropriate for the prisoner's medication to be removed. This will also include the name of the nurse making the decision.</p> <p>Healthcare staff are aware that the ACCT document should follow the patient throughout the establishment and this has been reiterated through emails and at the daily healthcare hand over meeting.
