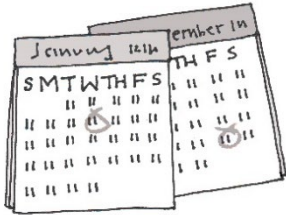
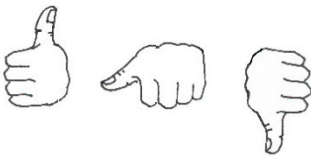




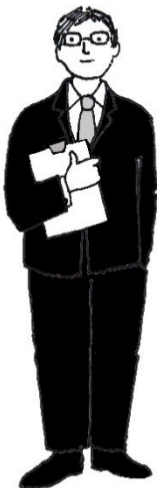
Inspection of HMP Feltham B



Inspectors visited this prison in September 2025.



We wanted to find out if things were better, the same or worse for prisoners since we last visited in 2023.



We did this by:

- looking around the prison
- asking prisoners and staff to fill in a questionnaire
- speaking to prisoners
- speaking to staff and helpers
- reading documents.

What did we find?



Safety: 2 out of 4

- There were too many drugs in the prison.
- Staff used force on prisoners too often.



Respect: 3 out of 4

- When prisoners did not understand English, staff were good at giving them information in other languages.
- Some staff did not give prisoners enough help to sort out their problems.
- Prisoners did not get enough to eat at mealtimes. Lots of prisoners said the food was not good enough.



Things to do: 1 out of 4

- Not enough prisoners were able to go to education, work or training.
- Some prisoners did not get the help they needed with reading.
- Prisoners with serious mental illness waited too long to go to hospital.
- Prisoners spent too long locked in their cells at weekends.



Getting ready to leave prison: 2 out of 4

- Prisoners did not see their key workers or offender managers often enough.
- The visits hall was nice and prisoners could have family visits once a month.

What should the prison do?



We want the governor to read the report we wrote about HMP Feltham B and make a plan.

The plan should tell us how they will fix the problems at HMP Feltham B and make things better for prisoners.

What do we want to happen?



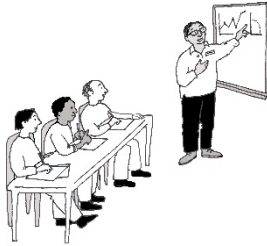
We want the prison to do more to stop drugs getting in.

We want more prisoners to go to education, training and work.



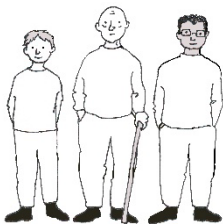
We want officers to only use force on prisoners when they really need to.



We want prisoners to get more help with their reading.



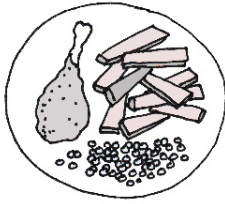
We want prisoners with serious mental illness to get to hospital more quickly.



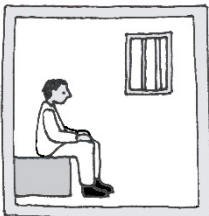
We want neurodivergent prisoners to get more help.



We want prisoners to be able to see their key workers and offender managers more often.

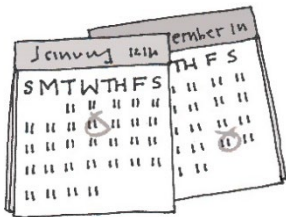


We want the food to be better. We want prisoners to get bigger meals.

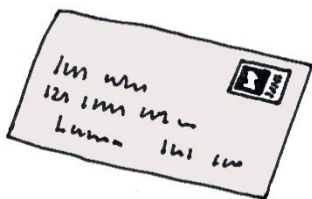


We want prisoners to get more time out of their cells at weekends.
