

The Brook House Inquiry is a statutory public inquiry set up to investigate mistreatment of detainees at Brook House IRC between 1 April 2017 and 31 August 2017, as shown by BBC Panorama in September 2017.



Three experts to the Inquiry: Cultural, Medical and Use of Force

The Inquiry has appointed Professor Mary Bosworth, Dr James Hard and Mr Jonathan Collier. Professor Bosworth will focus on the culture and management arrangements at Brook House, including issues relating to race. Dr Hard will focus on medical issues, and Mr Collier will focus on use of force issues.


