I, Detainee Custody Manager (DCM) Philip Page, have been working at Gatwick Immigration Removal Centre's (IRC) since July 2009. I am currently located at Tinsley House IRC. On the 29th June 2017 I was working at Brook House IRC responsible for Clyde and Dove wing. At approximately 12:40 I was monitoring the lunch serving on Dove wing when a detainee I later discovered to be **D2953** was coming down the stairs from the second level and he was wearing his underwear and a T Shirt, I stopped **D2953** and informed him that it was inappropriate for detainees to walk around the landings and attend the dinner queue without being properly dressed. He kept trying to walk past me and would not acknowledge my request to dress appropriately. Other detainees on the wing were walking past telling him to dress properly and asking me to make him be appropriate and some informed me that this was not the first time he was dressed like this. When I was trying to speak with **D2953** he kept repeating that he had been assaulted and he wanted compensation he said that the assault had happened on the 16th June. With the help of another detainee we convinced **D2953** to return to his room and put on a pair of trousers. I went back down the stairs and monitored the queue while I was there several detainees approached me to say **D2953** was causing issues and asked me what I would do about it. I informed them that as long as he followed my requests and if he was dressed decently there was nothing further for me to do.

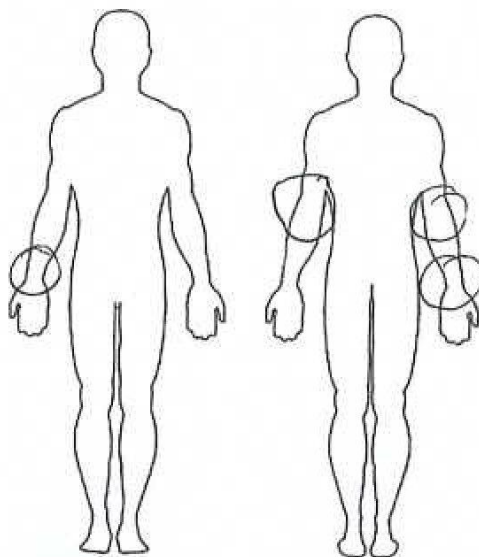
Shortly after I noticed **D2953** come down the stairs and he was now wearing a pair of shorts he appeared to join the dinner queue but began hovering around looking at what food was available. When he reached the front of the queue he was given the food that he had ordered and then he asked for something else, he was informed by Detainee Custody Officer (DCO) Ryan Bromley that he had what he ordered and he could only get something different if he waited until after everyone else was fed and we could make sure that everyone had the meal they requested and we could check if anything was left. **D2953** was demanding more food and he would not move along the line so I went over and asked him to move out of the way so that others could get their food. This continued in the same pattern as before with **D2953** telling me that he had been assaulted and he wanted more chicken. I continually informed him that by demanding he would not get what he wanted and he needed to



wait until everyone was fed and we would try to accommodate him. He continued to ignore me and the other detainees were becoming upset and irate as they were being held up. I told [D2953] that if he didn't move away from the server I would escort him away. By this time DCO Abdul Williams was next to us and I asked [D2953] to walk away one last time which he initially did, he was shouting and he picked up his bowls and he threw one on the floor then he threw the other one he was still shouting and moving towards me so I immediately took control of his right arm I noticed that DCO Williams had taken control of his left arm. I was contemplating placing [D2953] into a figure of four arm lock but he was not resisting me so I just held his arm. He appeared to be resisting DCO Williams but this soon ceased and DCO Williams had control. I called over my radio for some officers to attend Dove Wing so that we could relocate [D2953] to the care and separation unit (CSU). At this time DCO Slim Bessoud attended the wing he asked if I needed any assistance I asked him to assist DCO Bromley. As [D2953] was reasonably passive other than demanding food and compensation I asked DCO Williams to release his hold and move to a guiding hold so we could walk off of the wing. We left Dove Wing through the main door and made our way towards CSU when we reached the door to the area outside the kitchen. I asked DCO Williams to release his hold and open the door. I also released my hold and we continued to walk towards CSU. I informed [D2953] that as long as he remained calm and walked with us we would not need to restrain him further. We continued on our way towards CSU where we were joined by Oscar1 DCM Dave Aldis. We entered E Wing and I informed [D2953] that I needed him to walk across the room to the gate at the far end as he was walking across the room he kept saying that he wanted a room with a Television as I went to open the gate [D2953] stopped walking I went back to him and placed my right hand on his left arm and started to Move him towards the gate. He started to walk and I removed my hand. We walked through into CSU where we were met by DCO Alex Parpworth who I informed [D2953] would be carrying out his search before he entered the room. [D2953] would not raise his arms properly and myself and Abdul had to assist holding his arms up. I then walked with [D2953] into room 003 where I informed him that he had been relocated due to his disruptive behaviour and he would be seen by healthcare and we would return with his paperwork. Alf [D2953] did was demand a Television and food, at this point I left the room. As I was about to exit the wing I was met by Nurse Donna Batchelor who was going to check on [D2953] I returned to his room and Donna was trying to assess but all he kept on about was when he alleges he was assaulted and he would not comply with our requests, we once again left the room. This concludes my report at this time I am unaware of any injuries to anyone involved.

I Detention Custody Officer Abdul Williams am a DCO at Brook House IRC, as position I have held since April 2017 and I've been assigned to work on Delta Wing. I started my ITC course on 3rd April 2017 and During my ITC I successfully completed 1 week of C&R. I started my shift on 29th June at 07:45.

At 13:00 approximately on Dove Wing while lunch was been served I heard shouting at the servery where Detention Custody Manager Phil Page was talking to Detainee: **D2953** **D2953** (12354885). I walked over to assist DCM Phil Page with the situation. The detainee was shouting about wanting more food even though he has already been given his meal he's ordered. At this point the detainee started to get louder and aggressive, which then lead to him throwing his food all over the floor. I then took hold of the detainee left arm and put a guarding hold on. The detainee resisted which left me without a choice but to put a final lock on, I then told him to stop resisted which he did and from there I converted down to a figure four. I DCO Abdul Williams and DCM Phil Page then walked him out of Delta Wing and then changed to a guarding hold. While walking to CSU I released the guarding hold and the detainee walked the rest of the way. I DCO Abdul Williams and DCM Phil Page left the detainee: **D2953** in CSU room 003.

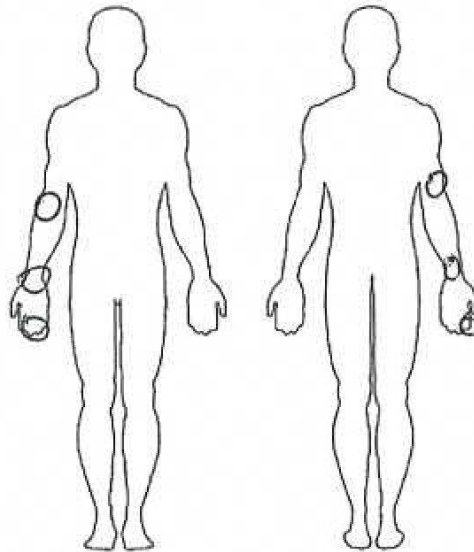

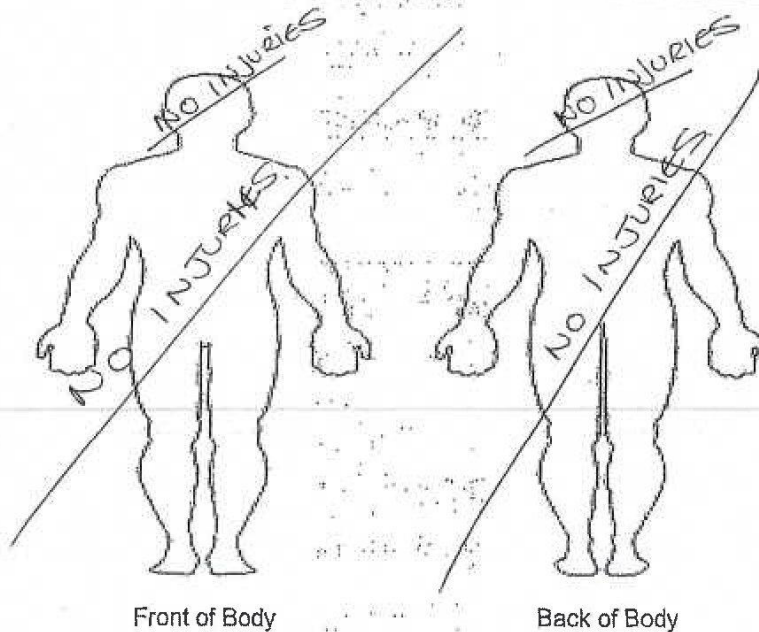
