As the complaint contains a criminal allegation, the Home Office has referred the matter to your force for you to consider if a crime should be recorded and investigated.

The individuals who are the subject of the complainants complaint are Detention Custody Officers contracted to the Home Office to provide detention and escorting functions. The Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 provides the officer with the legal power to use reasonable force when necessary on individuals being removed from the UK.

The PSU will continue to investigate this misconduct complaint unless your force intends to conduct a criminal investigation. In this case, I would be grateful if you would contact the Investigating Officer (IO) or the Assistant Investigating Officer (AIO) who may be able to assist you with the gathering of evidence
