I write in respect of the detainee named above in my capacity as an immigration removal centre medical practitioner. I hereby report that this detainee's health is likely to be injuriously affected by continued detention or the conditions of detention.

The above named detainee suffers from Post traumatic stress disorder. The cause of this disorder is the suffering he witnessed [eg bodys being blown apart by land mines and other horrific scenes] when he was serving as a front line soldier in Basra ,lraq in the years 2004-2005 and 2007-2008. He was medically discharged from the army. He has deep rooted depression and flash backs of the trauma he witnessed .Through this trauma he experienced he indulged in alcohol and lost his wife and child.
