to [D1527] throat. He could have sustained any level of injury as a result of having his airway and windpipe restricted. My understanding is that the British Medical Council have issued a suspension order in relation to the nurse who was present at the scene, but failed to report the matter or demonstrate that an appropriate examination of the prisoner had taken place following this incident.

The victim [D1527] does not speak English very, has a lack of respect for authority, has capacity issues and possible short term memory problems although access to medical records is being sought. There is a potential that the victim will lack any credibility if challenged in court due to the above mentioned.

In relation to the incident on the 24/04/17 when the victim was under constant supervision by DCO Sanders - This would appear when watching the film that SANDERS is actually acting within the boundaries of reasonable force by preventing the victim from causing injury to himself - the negative is when he states that he looks outside the cell to make sure no one is watching. This is a verbal comment made by him to colleagues and would appear to be "Biggering himself up". There is no corroboration of the offence.

Potentially the identified witness FRANCIS may provide conflicting account for defence as refused to provide statement.
