He said that he and his colleagues would slash detainees' arms with ... oh fuck this. This is bullshit.

This is not going to happen, by the way, I will just say "detainees" because I'm so used to saying it. So we can keep trying but we could be here for a while.

So Yan was basically telling me what he and his colleagues used to do when they worked at HMP Wandsworth. And he was basically saying to me they did things like smash prisoners' heads onto sinks and sometimes so hard that the sink in the cell would actually break.

He told me that they'd slash prisoners' arms with razor blades to make it look like they'd self-harmed to justify use of force.

He said that they kick prisoners' heads in and just generally beat the living daylights out of some of the prisoners at Wandsworth.
