What his demeanour was when he said this to you.- Frustrated

What warning you gave to G4S officers and Immigration Managers about his intentions.- Informed the Immigration Managers, G4S Manager and G4S Staff about detainee's intention (cannot remember names)

What contact you had with healthcare – Healthcare was aware of his ongoing issue with NPS usage.

What previous threats to self harm he had made that you were aware of – None

Why you did not open an ACDT – I didn't open an ACDT as I managed to calm him down by explaining the procedures of Immigration but informed that Managers to make them aware, the G4S managers spoke to him and didn't feel it was necessary at that time.

Later an Part C raise by DCM D.Roofey at Brook House: ACDT opened on Mr D687 as 'he has made threats to take an overdose to the RAPT Team. Brook House mental health team aware as well.

What you understand your responsibility is about opening an ACDT – If a detainee makes a threat to self harm an ACDT needs to opened if we feel it's a serious threat.

What training you have had about ACDT – Contactors classroom training

What training you have had about what to do when someone makes a threat to self harm - How to open an ACDT and what to do in that situation.
