Introduction

1. I am currently the Head of PSU Operations and have been in this role since 7 December

2020. I have essentially taken over the role that was held by Mark Harley-King, who is

sadly unable to attend the Inquiry due to ill health.

2. Prior to joining the PSU (including during what I understand to be the relevant period

for the purpose of the Inquiry) I was a civil servant at HMRC, most recently in the

Commercial Directorate at Grade 7 level. Prior to that I had 15 years' experience in

HMRC's internal governance unit as an investigator and manager. I have also held

various roles of an investigatory nature within HM Customs & Excise.

3. I have read the statement of Mr Hartley-King dated 29 October 2021 [HOM0331946].

Whilst I have not yet had a chance to read all of the documents that underlie his

statement (and did not have any involvement in the matters referred to) I have no reason

to doubt the information that is contained in the statement, and I will do my best to
