The SMT were</p> <p>9 barely visible. Members of the SMT, like</p> <p>10 Jules Williams, were close to abusive members of staff</p> <p>11 like Graham Panel. So people like myself had no</p> <p>12 confidence that going to the SMT would be anything other</p> <p>13 than fruitless and whose word was it going to be? The</p> <p>14 word of a DCO against the word of a DCM? Much of</p> <p>15 the abuse would happen inside cells in which there were</p> <p>16 no cameras. So how you would substantiate any of your</p> <p>17 complaints would be very difficult unless you had other</p> <p>18 officers who would co-operate with you. But my</p> <p>19 experience was most staff were too scared to raise</p> <p>20 concerns.</p> <p>21 MR ALTMAN: I see the time. For some of us, it's been</p> <p>22 a long day, Mr Tulley.
