The Professional Standards Unit have conducted an investigation into the complaint following an allegation of “excessive force was used by officers during his removal” made by [REDACTED] D1234 his allegation was made whilst [REDACTED] D1234 was detained at during escorting.

The allegations were unsubstantiated.

Two recommendations have been made in this report. Concerning recommendation 8.7.2, I have asked for clarification from the Use of Force monitor on this; I will keep you informed on the outcome of this.
