Case review carried out in the C-wing office, Mr D1527 looked visibly more rested and appeared to be happy to engage in the review.

Mr D1527 has been seen around the Centre laughing and joking with other detainees and enjoying games of pool on the wing but it appears that when he is approached by staff his demeanour changes and he lacks eye contact when being spoken to. I asked Mr D1527 how he was today to which he replied fine, I asked if he had had some sleep as he looked better and he agreed that he had slept well, I tried to discuss with Mr D1527 why he was so low yesterday but he wouldn't say just replying that he is fine. I asked Mr D1527 if he ate yesterday but he said no, I asked if he was going to eat today and he replied by saying maybe but again not wanting to discuss the subject further, Mr D1527 was asked about any intentions of self-harm or suicide both of which he said he had no thoughts or intentions at present, at this stage K.Churcher challenged this asking why he had told her differently yesterday Mr D1527 just replied by saying he didn't know. Mr D1527 was reluctant to engage in conversation and was not willing to elaborate on issues he may be experiencing at present despite numerous attempts to get him to open up. Mr D1527 was reminded that he has an RMN appointment today at 1830 of which he agreed that he would attend.

Due to the appearance of low mood and lack of engagement level of care to remain the same at hourly observations and mealtime observations.

Emergency case review held after D1527's room mate pressed the call bell informing officers that D1527 had cut himself. A noose was also found upon entry to the room. D1527 had made very small superficial cuts to his wrist and stated he did so with his finger nails, Healthcare were on scene and had no concerns with the injuries.

D1527 was under his duvet and refused to get out of bed or speak to us, after a long while D1527 decided to come with us to Eden wing so we could talk.

D1527 wouldn't make eye contact and kept saying he was fine, we tried several times to get D1527 to open up to us but he would either not reply or say that we would not understand.

We reiterated that we are all here to help him and that he needs to talk with us if he wants our help, he just replied saying he doesn't need our help. We suggested that he tried to get some sleep and he said he would try.

Healthcare informed us that he has an appointment with the doctor tomorrow 24/04/2017.

Observations set at 2 per hour and a review to take place later on today. Preferably after his appointment.

Summary of review (if ACDT plan is closed, state why)

Mr **D1527** stated he harmed himself as he had been placed on Eden Wing and wanted to return to his room as this would stop him doing it. We explored the fact he was on Eden wing because he was in a room with his friends and harmed himself. Mr **D1527** is not eating and says he will harm himself if he doesn't go back to a room, he also said he won't eat unless he goes back to his room. His room is no longer available. He made no eye contact throughout and appeared manipulative in his responses. He spoke minimally but seemed to only respond when he wanted something and made threats when he was informed as to the reasons why he was on the document and why he was on Eden wing. He has a solicitor and has claimed asylum, he would not discuss his triggers. All agreed remain on same level of obs based on his responses and his demeanour throughout the review.

Summary of review (if ACDT plan is closed, state why)

D1527 is currently residing on Eden wing on a constant supervision. Yesterday D1527 attempted to eat a battery from his phone and later in the evening he attempted to strangle himself with a t-shirt he was also moved to rule 40 as he had refused to return to Eden wing on a number of occasions. The review of his rule 40 took place prior to this review and it was agreed that D1527 no longer needed to be on rule 40 so his door could remain open and he could take part in the E wing regimes.

The review was conducted in the Eden wing office, those listed above contributed as detailed. D1527 entered the room and sat down, those present introduced themselves and the purpose of the review was explained to him. D1527 has a good level of English so a translator was not necessary.

D1527 did not fully engage with the review he was despondent and seemed disconnected throughout. His body language was withdrawn and he made little to no eye contact, his responses were mumbled and quiet. Since D1527 has been on constant supervision he has made self-harm attempts on a daily basis, when asked what triggered this he stated that he has flashbacks which caused them. D1527 suggested that he could not dismiss his thoughts and medication was not helping to control flashbacks. When asked if he would self-harm if he were to return to general population he stated they would. He did not answer when asked if he wanted to die he said that it would be better to die here than in Egypt. There is currently no removal in place for D1527 and he knows this, but it does not change his thinking. He was asked if he is perusing release and he said he did not want to be released. He has a solicitor that he is in contact with and said that something would happen soon. He would not elaborate on this and it was felt that this was meant as an implicit threat suggesting he would attempt to harm himself soon.

D1527 was asked what support he felt he needed and he could not think of anything, he currently appears to be making no effort to support himself or progress his case meaning his situation is likely to stagnate. The only thing D1527 seems to want is to move to a general population wing and share a room. He stated that he would self-harm again if this did not happen but also would give no assurance that his thoughts of harming would subside should he move as he was sharing a room in general population when he initially self-harmed triggering the constant supervision.

It was the decision of those present that D1527 posed a high risk and that he should remain on constant supervision.

Summary of review (if ACDT plan is closed, state why)

D1527 willingly attended his case review. He has a good understanding of the English word so translation was not required.

Prior to his review, **D1527** was observed playing pool and engaging with other detainees. The review was opened by asking **D1527** how he was feeling. **D1527** said he was feeling a lot brighter – I enquired what had changed in the last 24 hours and **D1527** said he was in “a better place and was thinking differently” I explored his comments about “something happening” and what that meant, **D1527** said he was referring to his friend coming to visit and it wasn’t anything untoward. I enquired when this was and **D1527** said that his friend was trying to arrange a visit but he couldn’t get through to book one – it was agreed if he provides the details, we will assist him with this. He explained that his battery on his phone was not working (this was because he put it in his mouth on Tuesday) – DCM Harris agreed to provide **D1527** with another one today. When asked directly about thoughts of self harm, **D1527** said that he currently didn’t and reiterated this again during the review. **D1527** said he was keen to return to the Wings and attend the Mosque. I agreed that **D1527** can attend Mosque and that pending a period of 24 hours without constant supervision; we will look to return him to full residential units tomorrow. **D1527** was happy with this decision and provided assurances that he will not hurt himself. In view of how **D1527** is presenting and no current thoughts of self harm (or recent acts in past 36 hours) panel agrees –


Summary of review (if ACDT plan is closed, state why)

Details: **D1527** attended the review today in the talking therapy room he was happy to take part, he speaks good English so big word did not need to be used. When I spoke with **D1527** he spoke clearly but in a low tone and when I asked him how he was he stated that everything was fine but when he said this he would not look at me he would always look at the floor. he said if you ask me how I am I will always say I am fine because nothing matters so everything was fine I said to him that if he is not happy or if he is feeling low then this is not ok and we need to address it he said that he was fine and did not want to talk about it any more. I asked if **D1527** if his phone issue was sorted out he replied that it had been done yesterday I also asked if he had got a visit sorted out yet he replied that not really if they come then they come if they don't then they don't during the review he didn't really seem like he wanted to engage with me so I asked him if he had anything he would want to ask me but he said that he didn't I asked around the room if any one had anything that they wanted to ask, Paul asked more about his visit and if he had family that would come and see him he said that he didn't but his friend lives in London. As it appeared that we were coming to the end of conversation we ended the review and **D1527** left the room with Paul and when Paul returned we all chatted and it was decided that his observations should remain the same.

Reviewed D1527 this afternoon in his room, he presented him self in a joyful mood and in good spirits, he had good eye contact with me and was laughing and joking with me.
I asked him why he is not eating; he stated that he does eat from the shop and that he gets fruit from the servery and from his friends, he stated that he is not protesting nor is he on a hunger strike, I then asked him about how he was feeling, has he got any thoughts of harming himself, he stated not at present, I have me friends around me they look after me and help me, he then thanked me for getting his old roommate from A wing transferred to D Wing and into his roommate he said that this is helping me a lot.
I spoke to S Levett in-regards to his immigration issues and I was informed that he currently has no removal directions in place and that they haven't applied for an emergency travel document as of yet.
D1527 has a solicitor but has not yet applied for bail, but he told me that he has an address were he could stay if he gets released.
Due to D1527 being more settled it was decided that his level of care can now be reduced to 1 x observation every 3 hours and 1 x conversation.

I asked him how he was feeling and said that he was ok, no problems, I asked him again about him not eating, he gave me the same reply as at the weekend, but since the weekend he has bought more food from the shop, he said that he is eating that and drinking, I asked if he was sleeping ok he replied yes.

I asked him if he has any thoughts about hurting himself he stated not at present, I asked him if he would speak to a member of staff if he was feeling in low mood, he stated that he might but wouldn't guarantee it.
On speaking with healthcare they have told me that they have changed his medication and this will start tonight, they also took bloods this morning and depending on this his meds could change again.

Home office has stated that they have no further updates, no ETD has been requested subsequently no removals are imminent.

It was decided by all present that his level of care can be reduced to 4 x observations per day including mealtime obs and 1 x conversation.

Case review carried out in Eden wing room 008. Information given by day Oscar one S.Dix stating that Mr D1527 had been relocated to Eden wing following the use of force after Mr D1527 jumped on the netting, Mr D1527 was initially placed onto a constant supervision following this use of force. Case review not completed at the time due to other incidents within the centre.

Mr D1527 was in good spirits and was happy to engage in the review, he made good eye contact and was smiling throughout the review, I asked Mr D1527 why he had jumped on the netting earlier to which he did not give a reason but apologised saying that it would not happen again. Mr D1527 agreed that he understood why force was used and the reasons why he had been placed onto rule 40, Mr D1527 stated that he has no thoughts of intentions of self-harm and stated that he felt good at present. Mr D1527 was asked if he had any injuries in which he would like healthcare to look at but he said no and said he was good thank you. I explained to Mr D1527 that his rule 40 would be reviewed in the morning and to try and get a good nights rest in the meantime, he agreed he would and that in future he would approach staff if he had any concerns. Level of care changed to hourly observations with another review set for tomorrow (05/05/17).

D1527 attended the case review and, good eye contact and spoke clearly throughout the case review. I asked **D1527** how he was and he said he was doing better. I praised **D1527** as he had been doing very well since he had been on Clyde wing. **D1527** stated that he gets on well with his current room mate and has an RMN appointment on the 13th May, however **D1527** said he was unsure what time the appointment was. I phone RMN James Newlands who said that it would be at 11:00 on the 13th May. **D1527** thanked me but said he kept forgetting his appointments and medication times. I suggested that he set a reminder on his phone for his medication times and his appointments. **D1527** agreed to do this. **D1527** stated that his current medication was not helping him very well at night and that he had been to see the nurse at drop in clinic times but it had been of no help. I explained that the RMN appointment would assist him better with this. DCO O Puntangon advised going to the arts and craft/ language lessons. **D1527** stated that he had tried but it did not interest him. I advised that I had spoken to the home office who have informed me that there are no removal directions in place and that he should consider applying for bail. **D1527** stated that his solicitor was on leave for the next 2-3 days but has another number to assist him in the meant time. I advised him to call his solicitor when they are back to discuss his options. **D1527** recently came off a food refusal but went back on yesterday as he had not eaten a meal from the servery. **D1527** stated that he has no appetite but is eating dates from the shop. I advised that we wanted **D1527** to eat so that he could keep strong. I informed **D1527** that staff will encourage him to eat from the servery. DCO O Puntangon said that **D1527** was welcome to come and have a chat with her anytime during the day.

Following an emotional/aggressive outburst this morning by **D1527** it was deemed necessary to carry out this case review. **D1527** had been challenged for his ID card upon entry to the wing and refused to show it and was screaming at the officer to move out of the way and that he didn't want to speak to anyone. I attempted to speak with **D1527** shortly after this but he slammed the door in my face and refused to engage, again saying he didn't want to speak to anyone. I left the room and a few minutes later DCO Murphy went to speak with **D1527** and he continued to rant. I attended the room with DCO Murphy and **D1527** again stated did not want to speak to any officers, only to his friend on D wing. **D1527** got up and left the room and went to D wing courtyard where he calmed down. DCO Ofori took a telephone call from Home Office stating that Mr **D1527** had received bad news and was in a rage because of this but **D1527** refuses to engage with anyone to discuss the matter. I have just returned to see **D1527** re his current state of mind and he again said he did not want to speak to anyone, I offered a male officer but he declined this also. I note from entries in the ACDT that he was seen in good spirits during the afternoon on the wing. I asked **D1527** if he had any thoughts of harming himself and he stated "you do not need to have any concerns about me" **D1527** is currently sharing his room with another Detainee. Due to **D1527**'s previous history I have increased observations to one every two hours with a further review to take place on 23/05/2017

The RMN's had told me as did Chrissie Williams from health care that he hasn't engaged with the healthcare when appointments had been made but they are concerned because no observations had been acquired. The last transactions from the shop were salted peanuts and a Coca Cola classic costing £2.75 on the 22.05.2017.
