Also so we can inform healthcare of any fluid intake. Staff have been advised not to let Mr **D1077** have any fizzy drinks or food he should only drink water and healthcare should be advised. Healthcare C Williams asked how he was feeling and his words to us was his stomach was burning like fire, however when I asked him if I could help him at all and if we could maybe send him to Hospital he stated that he would not go to Hospital. I asked Mr **D1077** if he was to be released in to Hospital would he start eating and drinking, his reply was yes he said that he was in detention for two years and just wants to be released. Mr **D1077** was asked if he had a release address and he said no I have no friends or family. Mr **D1077** is still refusing food and he is not refusing fluid but did not drink in front of myself or healthcare when asked, his cup was empty so it was filled up with clean water for him to drink. It was discussed with Healthcare that the observations would increase to Hourly Observations during the day period with Healthcare attending each hour to assess Mr **D1077** and he would be seen at 11.30 today by the Doctor. During the evening period at 21.00 hrs Mr **D1077** will be constant Observations to alert Healthcare of any changes.

I received information from C Williams Healthcare that they are trying every two hours to take observations on D1077. They will also keep trying to talk with him. A request has been put in to move him from the centre by the Doctor. He has been asked about the advanced directive and he has stated to the doctor that he does not want treatment. His refusal to engage in conversation is very frustrating he just wants to lay there and die. I again said to him today that this is a very painful way to die and he should think about what he is doing. As I left the room I did say that he should speak to the wing staff should he need anything. D1077 is to remain on the same observations Mealtime time conversations and 2 observations overnight.

He again started to have a go at skeet I said he only wants to check his health. I said he should have some thoughts about where his situation is going and it is only him that can change it. We then left the room. D1077 to remain on Mealtime observations with 3 conversations encouraging him to eat plus 2 observations overnight.

Doctor Chowdhury stated that we should continue to observe and encourage D1077 to eat. Doctor Chowdhury also said that with the levels of anger that D1077 is displaying he believes he will want to start eating eventually.

I spoke to Liz from the home office who informed me that that there was no update on D1077's case at this time.

D1077 was laying in bed facing the wall, I asked if he would be able to come to the wing office to carry out his case review however he advised me to go away as he was resting which I thought was odd as he been assessed by the Senior RMN Karen Churcher this morning at approximately 08:30. I asked D1077 if he was going to eat today but he said he wouldn't. I therefore left the room so not to annoy D1077 any further.

I spoke to Edwina and Simon from the Home office who informed me that there was no update on the progress of D1077's immigration case this was mainly down to the fact that he had not attended The Moroccan Embassy interview on 2 occasions since being at Brook House which is delaying his Emergency Travel Document in order to get him back to Morocco which we understand is what he wants from previous conversations recorded. Karen Churcher the Senior RMN stated that his observations were ok this morning, his lips were moist and he has said that he is drinking water. However D1077 has still not eaten and therefore remains on a food and fluid refusal.

Information from the Home office is that a Moroccan IV scheme was at Brook House 17/07/2017 and D1077 refused to attend according to there systems, and they do not know when this will be re-set. Information from Healthcare is that he is not engaging with them for the last few days and his current BRAG rating is Amber.

D1077 states he will not eat until he returns but says there is nothing else bothering him, he says he has no thoughts of self harm or suicide.

I informed **D1077** that I, Ben and Karen Churcher the senior RMN were very concerned about him as he had not been eating. I asked **D1077** how long he had not eaten or had a drink for and he stated 8 to 9 days **D1077** stated that this was his protest against the home office.

I informed **D1077** that Karen Churcher had asked that he be moved to Eden wing for closer observations in regard to his food and fluid intake. **D1077** agreed but stated he wasn't able to walk as he felt too weak. I offered him the use of the evacuation chair and he agreed to use this. To protect **D1077**'s dignity I have decided to move **D1077** at 17:00 lock down so that the other detainees do not see him being moved to Eden wing.

As a case review team we agreed to alter the level care to 3 conversations per day at meal times to encourage **D1077** to eat and drink plus 2 night observations.

D1077 flat refused to attend an ACDT case review, despite having been informed by DCM C Donnelly this morning, and agreeing to attend then. He said "I don't want to talk to anybody" I tried to persuade him, but he refused. I spoke to RMN Churcher regarding D1077, and she informed me that when he arrived at Brook House he advised healthcare he was on anti - psychotic medication (low dose) and that he "hears voices" but he did not arrive from previous IRC with any such meds, and there is nothing in his med notes. He has not seen a GP at Brook House regarding this. He has been given 2 appointments, the most recent yesterday, for RMN assessments, but has not attended either time. He has another opportunity on 10.07.17.

D1077 has not been an issue at Brook house since arriving, he was attacked this morning by another detainee this morning, but it seems to be an argument over food, and D1077 did not initiate or react violently.
