Incident Statement By (print name): Steve Loughton

Please describe the Incident details in full, confirming details of place of incident, time, date, names of all persons involved, witnesses, injuries sustained, first aid or healthcare provided, and details of which managers were informed of incident.

I detainee Custody Manager Steve Loughton have worked for G4S at Brook House Immigration Centre, Perimeter Road South, Gatwick Airport, RH6 0PQ since the centre opened in January 2009. Brook House accommodates 448 detainees prior to their removal from the United Kingdom or whilst their immigration cases are resolved.

I was working my second thirteen and a half hour shift at Brook House IRC and I was rostered to be working as Oscar 1. At approximately half past two on the afternoon of 31st May 2017 I was informed by the Duty Director of the day Caz Dance-Jones that she had received a report that a detainee by the name of D149 CID 1673654 had attempted to grab an officers keys in the library and that he has done this before in a previous centre so for the safety and security of the centre he is to be moved to our care and separation unit and be placed onto Rule 40. I made my way to Dove wing and asked for a call to be put out for Mr D149 to make his way to Dove wing office, on his arrival I spoke with him in the office and informed him of what we have had reported and that he needs to pack his belongings and walk down with me to our care and separation unit. Mr D149 became quite irate at hearing this news and denied that any of the events mentioned happened and that he would not be going to the "block" as he had done nothing wrong, I explained to him that the cameras had been looked at which backed up the officers reports and I again informed him that he needs to walk with me down to our care and separation unit. Mr D149 told me in an aggressive manner that he was not going to go anywhere and he left the office. Because of the time of day I did not pursue the matter as the centre was on association time which means all the detainees in the centre were out of their rooms so I left it and spoke with Caz Dance-Jones and informed her that we would go back to Mr D149's room at approximately five O'clock when the centre was in lockdown for dinner time roll count and there were no other detainees out of their rooms. I then assembled a team of four officers who were certificated in the use of force and asked them to meet me in full kit at 16.45 in the second floor staff room which is where I was going to carry out the briefing for the planned intervention to remove Mr D149 to our care and separation unit, I also informed our healthcare department of what was going to happen and asked them to be present also.

Incident Statement By (print name): Steve Loughton

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I was then asked to make my way to Dove wing office as Mr D149 would like to talk to me, on arrival Mr D149 was sitting on the ground floor at a table so I went and spoke with him and he kept repeating himself by saying that he was not going to the "block" as he had done nothing wrong, I again informed him that he would be going to the care and separation unit and it was in his best interests to walk with me compliantly and he could speak with the duty director in the morning but he again stated that he wasn't going anywhere so I again walked away from him as we were still on association time. At approximately 16.30 I was walking along the central corridor on route to the second floor staff room and I again came across Mr D149 who seemed very agitated and asked me what was going to happen, I replied that he will be going down to our care and separation unit at some point today, Mr D149 then became quite aggressive with me stating that I didn't know who he was and that I will see what happens if I come and see him, so again I left the situation and made my way to the second floor staff room. Once I was in the staff room and everyone who needed to be there was present I conducted the briefing (Attached). I was then informed that Mr D149 was refusing to go to his room so I made my way to Dove wing, on arrival DCM Shadbolt was communicating with Mr D149 and managed to get him behind his door. I then returned to the staff room and we all made our way to Dove wing, we made our way to room 206, I then looked through the viewing panel and saw Mr D149 was laying on his bed, I opened the door and presented the team in the doorway and informed him what was going to be happening and that he needed to exit his room and walk with the officers down to our care and separation unit, Mr D149 again stated that he had done nothing wrong but he got up and very reluctantly exited the room, I asked Mr D149 to stand with his back to the wall and the officers would explain to him how he was going to be escorted. Mr D149 then refused to move so I again asked him to walk with the officers but he replied that he was going nowhere so I instructed the team to take control of him.

Steve Loughton

Please describe the Incident details in full, confirming details of place of incident, time, date, names of all persons involved, witnesses, injuries sustained, first aid or healthcare provided, and details of which managers were informed of incident.

Mr D149 started fighting with the officers he was taken to the floor and the support officer DCO Freeburn took control of his legs as he was attempting to kick officers, I the applied the handcuffs to Mr D149 at approximately 17.19, he was then lifted by the officers and walked to the end of the top floor of Dove wing, Mr D149 then became very abusive and threatening towards myself by stating that he was going to kill me and all my family and he was also threatening all the officers present. The team the made their way out of Dove wing and along the corridor to the top of the stairs, I made sure a couple of times that the nurse checked Mr D149 to see if he had any injuries but that was quite hard to do as he was so non-compliant and aggressive towards anyone who went near him. When we got to the top of the stairs Mr D149 was still fighting and threatening and so that we went down the stairs safely I asked DCO Sayers and DCO Bromley who were present if they could assist as being anchor men which dramatically reduced the risk of anyone falling down the stairs which could have resulted in injury to staff or Mr D149. When we had got down to the ground floor DCO Sayers and Bromley took no further part in the intervention. Mr D149 was then walked along the ground floor through Eden Wing and into our Care and separation unit, when we arrived in our care and separation unit Mr D149 was allowed to stand up whilst still being in handcuffs, he then looked at all present and again was very threatening towards staff stating that he was going to kill us and our families. DCO Croucher then conducted a search on Mr D149 and as he was still very aggressive and non-compliant I decided that a full relocation was going to be carried out, Mr D149 was walked into the room which is when I asked a nurse to give him one last check over, the handcuffs were removed by myself at approximately 17.35 and the full relocation took place and then when the staff had exited the room I closed the door. The camera was kept on Mr D149 through the viewing panel and also the healthcare team observed him. Because of the force used and he was still non-compliant he was to be constantly observed for his own well being and he was placed onto Rule 42. All involved then made our way back up to the second floor staff room where I carried out a de-brief of the intervention. There were no injuries to any staff.

Please describe the Incident details in full, confirming details of place of incident, time, date, names of all persons involved, witnesses, injuries sustained, first aid or healthcare provided, and details of which managers were informed of incident.

I Detainee Custody Manager (Dcm) Ben Shadbolt, I am currently employed by G4S Care and Justice Services at Brook House Immigration removal centre a position I have had for 5 years 10 months was on shift at Brook House Immigration Removal centre in the Care and separation unit when at the time of approximately 16:45 was asked by Oscar 1 DCM Steve Loughton for detainee that I know to be **D149** CID Ref: 1673654 who was required to be moved to the care and separation unit for attempting to take an officers keys. At 16:45 a briefing was held in the level 2 staff room where DCM Steve Loughton gave a briefing to the selected control and restraint team. Once the briefing was completed I then made my way to Dove wing to check to see if the wing was locked down for evening roll count so the planned intervention could go ahead where I found **D149** sitting on the sofa by the pool table on level one refusing to go to his room as he stated that he knew that the manager he spoke to earlier was up to something when he was asked to elaborate where **D149** stated that he was accused of trying to take an officers keys to which he stated that he didn't and that he wanted to speak to DCM Steve Loughton and was not going to move until he did after speaking to him and explaining to him that once roll count was correct then I would get Steve to come and speak to him after repeating myself a numerous amount of times **D149** then walked to his room where he was now contained. **D149** was stating that he was not going to be going to the "block" what so ever and no one would make him go down there and he would cause trouble and "FUCK PEOPLE UP" once **D149** was in his room and the door was secure I then made my way back to the staff room to update the DCM Loughton. We then went to room 206 on Dove wing where DCM Loughton opened the door to open dialect with **D149** and explained to him that he would be going to the care and separation unit and asked him to compliantly walk with him and the kitted team to the care and separation and again explained the reason why. **D149** exited the room and stood with his back against the wall as asked and then refused to move from there the team was instructed to take control of **D149** where his attitude and aggression escalated **D149** was kicking and attempting to trip up the officer as well as trying to bite the officers throughout the incident and was verbally abusive to the officers involved and to DCM Steve Loughton making threats towards them and their families making threats to kill them and to "FUCK THEM ALL" and that he had people to fuck them up also. As the team left the wing with **D149** healthcare was asked to carry out an observation again where they stated that they had no concerns at this time they then went down the activity staircase where DCO Sayers and DCO Bromley were then appointed as supporting officer to anchor all those involved safely down the stairs.

Once the team had reached the bottom of the stairs the anchoring officers then stepped away from the intervention where D149 was led through the central corridor on the ground floor and through into Eden wing upon arriving on the care and separation it was requested that D149 was searched whilst the officer was attempting to search him D149 continued to kick out at the officer once the search was completed D149 was escorted in to room 002 and a full re-location was carried out where healthcare then checked on him again.

As the re-location was completed and the last officer was exiting the room [D149] then got up and ran for the door where it was closed by DCM Loughton before he could grab the door [D149] was shown on camera again at the door shouting and being abusive and threatening towards staff where a member of healthcare also confirmed that there was no cause for concerns from a medical point of view. An officer was then placed at the door to carry out constant supervision of [D149] as use of force was used and was in post closure stage of and ACDT Document. A hot de-brief was then conducted in the level 2 staff room. This concludes my report.
