Content of Report

At approximately 1430 I was standing at B-Wing door speaking to another detainee about his bail hearing. When closing the wing door, [D287] was sitting on the table by the door and asked for some advice on what "tricks" to use to stop him being returned to prison because he had just refused. I explained to him that there aren't any tricks and immigration will reset the move for another day and most of the time it is easier to comply with what is being asked of him rather than resisting it. I asked [D287] why he did not want to return to prison to which he responded that immigration have told his solicitor that he is not fit for detention because of something that happened when he was in Morton Hall. He also said that he had already finished his sentence. [D287] then asked if I was able to access what security intel there was on him because he had been put to sit right in front of officers twice in a row when he has had visits and had been told by a detainee who had been here before ([D162]) that the first time is procedure but the second time means that security is "on to him". I told [D287] that where he was sat in the visits hall is based purely on the seating space available at the time. [D287] continued to ask the best trick to stop him being moved back to HMP. He said that he had been told by "other sources" that razor blades would be the best thing and asked if I have seen it work before. [D287] because he really does not want to go back because he wanted to apply for bail. I told [D287] no and that the best thing to do would be to put in a request to speak with immigration. [D287] continued to ask if threat of razor blades would work to stop him being sent back to prison because if it would work then he might have to do that. Again I said no it is not worth it and went into the wing office. [D287] came into the wing office at approximately 15:35 and asked if I had checked his security markers. I said no and he left the office. This concludes my report.
