### Content of Report

**D68** spoke to detainee custody manager (DCM) Ian MacDonald around 1740 and informed him that he wanted to talk with a senior manager and a further 2 managers as witnesses as he had important information to give. It was believed that this information was to do with the drug culture within the centre as **D68** had mentioned during his review earlier to DCM Steve Webb that he had been offered drugs whilst on general population but was hesitant to give information. Duty Director Dan Haughton was contacted and attended the Eden wing office at around 1800. **D68** was invited into the office and attended of his own accord.

**D68** seemed calm and composed he was informed that those present were her to listen to the information he had to give. **D68** explained calmly that he had been detained for 28 days and that legally he could not be detained any longer. He stated that at midnight tonight should he still be in detention he would begin to kick and bang his door to harm himself. When asked why he would do this he explained that he is too ill to be detained as he suffers from panic attacks and that he could not be removed because of this and he has lost his patients with the process and believes he should not be detained. It was explained that this action would not help progress his case in anyway. **D68** did not care about that. He went on to say that he would bang his head on the door or wall and that if we came into the room we would not be able to touch him and would become more and more aggressive until he became tired and then he would go to sleep.

**D68** was asked if there was anything that could help him or deter this action to which he stated that he either wanted to be given diazepam (as he is withdrawing) or to be released. **D68** has been seen by nurses and doctors and has been told that he cannot be given any medication as he is not eating and has not eaten for 8 days. **D68** states that he cannot eat without either alcohol or cannabis. He declared that he is a substance user and has not taken anything for a few days. A number of options were explored to help **D68** but he would not engage in conversation about him perusing bail or release saying that he would not get it as he does not have a "British" reference. He would not listen when told this is not a barrier. He was asked if he has any legal support, **D68** said he had a solicitor but he annoyed him so he no longer has a solicitor. He has rejected family visits as he is ashamed about his situation.

**D68** was asked if it was his intention to die, he indicated that he would rather die than return to Turkey and that he is annoyed but went onto to say that kicking the door and banging his head would be because of a panic attack and would use his energy so he could sleep again before waking up to do it again. He was pressed on this as he claims to have suffered from panic attacks since birth but they are not daily. When asked why he has not behaved like this before when having a panic attack he said that he received a letter today from the Home Office to say that he would be deported to Turkey. He was challenged to say that this was the reason for his decision to change his behaviour to which he agreed but said the stress brings on a panic attack.

It is believed from the review that **D68** has made these threats to either obtain medication or initiate a release process, he did not seem interested in talking to a doctor about a rule 35 assessment even though he claims not to be fit for detention. His threats to kick the door and bang his head are genuine but that his intention is not to die but to manipulate.

**D68** is currently on Eden wing as he was being monitored for food and fluid intake, it was agreed to increase **D68** night time observations to reflect the change in risk.
