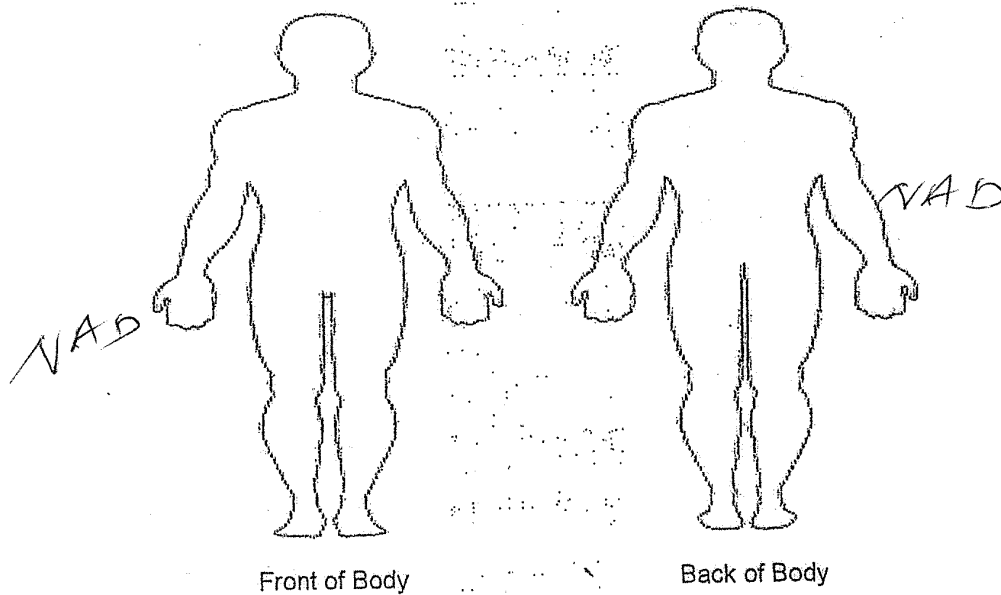

Sir, I Andrew Lyden am a Detainee Custody Officer (DCO) employed by G4S at Brook House Immigration Removal Centre (IRC). This Statement is based on my personal knowledge and experience of this incident, except where I indicate otherwise. I have 7 service as an officer 5 of which I have held the position of Detainee Custody Manager. During this period I have completed a G4S Initial Training Course (ITC) and during this period have attended Six annual use of force refresher courses including the last course on 12.12.2016.

On the 04/05/2017 I was working a night shift which started at 21:00 on the 03/05/2017, at 03:30 I was informed that detainee **D1251** CID 9835919 had to go to discharge as he was due to go on a Charter flight to Albania, Detainee **D1251** was currently on an open ACDT.

At the time of the call we had just completed a move for detainee **D2208** 11924566 from Becks wing to the Care and separation unit where a full search had taken place, 4 officers were still on the unit in PPE.

I asked DCO D Murphey to come with me to the room which was Eden wing room 013 and speak to **D1251** and help escort him to discharge.

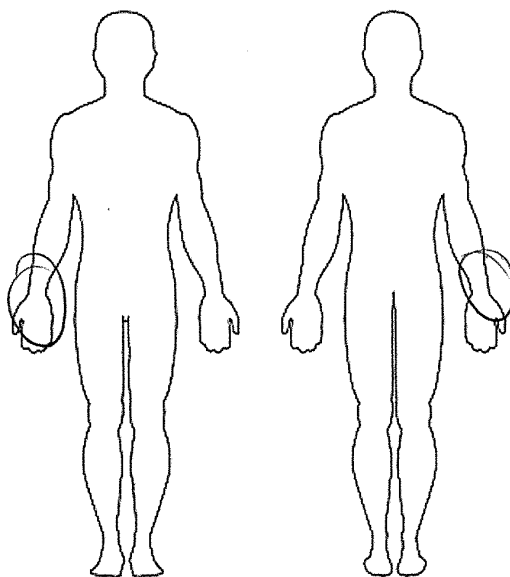
When I entered the room detainee **D1251** was in bed on the right side bed, I woke him up to inform him of the flight, he said he wasn't going to go and then straight away tried to put something in his mouth at this point I moved towards him and took hold of his right arm to try and stop him and DCO Murphey took hold of his head, I moved his right arm away from his body and moved it to the rest position to the back of his body.

DCO Murphey and I saw a small part of a razor blade fall from the detainees' mouth although he said that he had swallowed it.

At this point DCO Walker, Parpworth and McMillian entered the room as they were still in the office from the previous incident. DCO McMillian relieved me and took hold of the right arm I then moved away from the detainee switching on the Body Worn Camera.

Detainee **D1251** was then hand cuffed by the officers and escorted to discharge and handed over to Tascor overseas escorts for a Charter flight

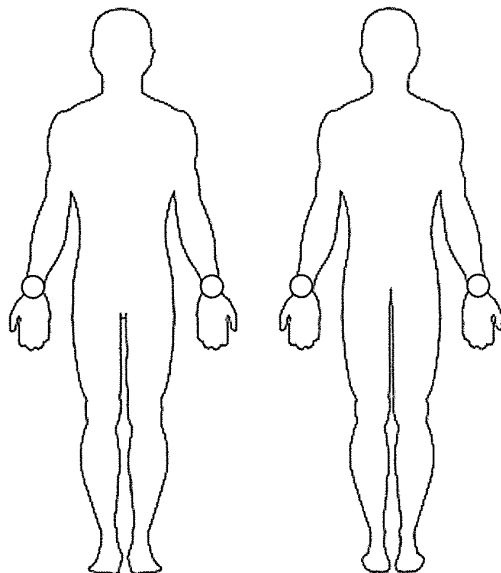

I Detainee Custody Officer George Walker was on duty on Thursday thr 4th may, 2017, at Brook House Immigration centre, Gatwick Airport, where I have been employed as a Detainee Custody Officer for 5 years. At the time of the incident, 03:45 approximately, I was into my third night shift out of 7.

I had just finished on a planned no notice removal for another detainee where no force was used and I had to be in full PPE as a precaution, I was in Eden wing officer removing some of my PPE and was waiting to get be taken to the staff room as I did not have keys on my person to get through the door. From what I understand during this time a detainee on Eden wing was being informed by Detainee custody Manager Andy Lyden that he would be going on a chartered flight and if he could walk to reception with him whilst I was not present in the room during that time I heard a call for assistance and entered the room at 03:45 am on the morning of the 04/05/2017 and applied hand cuffs as detainee () was being restrained to ensure the detainees safety and the officers safety as he had produced a blade the detainee was then escorted to reception discharge area at 03:51 and I removed the hand cuffs this concludes my report.

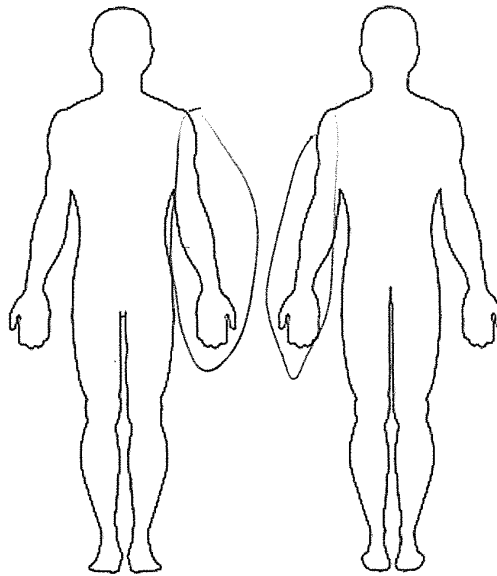

I Detainee Custody Officer Alex Parpworth started work at Brook House Immigration Removal Centre on 03 May 2017 at 21:00 for a nightshift. At approximately 03:35 on the morning of 4th May, I was in E wing office after a planned removal had taken place. At this time Detainee Custody Manager Andy Lyden was speaking with detainee **D1251** (cid:9835919) in E013 because he was due to leave for a flight. I became aware of a commotion in the room and entered, I took control of **D1251** left arm; he had been restrained for safety reasons due to stating that he had a blade in his mouth. I put him into a straight arm lock, and then manoeuvred into the final lock position. He was struggling against me during this. It was decided that **D1251** should be handcuffed, so I placed his arm behind his back for this purpose. I then supported his arm while we made our way from E wing, down to discharge, where we handed him over to the waiting escorts. This concludes my report

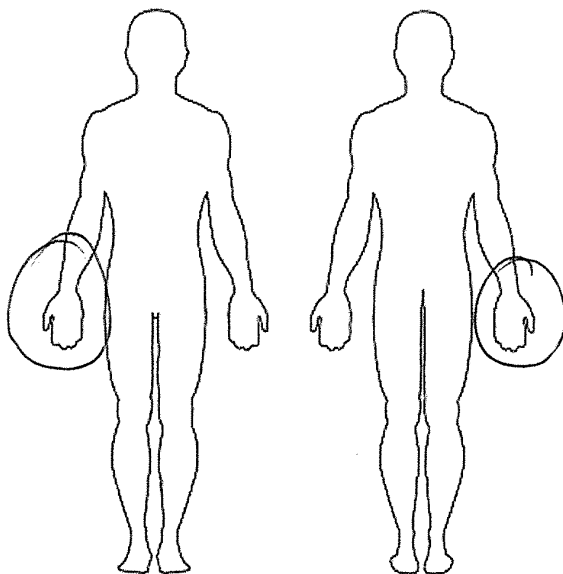
I Detainee Custody Officer (DCO) Tamzine McMillan have been a DCO at Brook House Immigration Removal Centre, Perimeter Road South, Gatwick, Crawley, RH10 0PQ since August 2016. I have been trained in Control and Restraint (C&R) techniques and first aid and am currently in ticket.

I was working my third night shift. I had just finished escorting another detainee down to the care and separation unit. I had made my way through to Eden wing and was situated in the wing office as Detainee Custody Manager (DCM) Andy Lyden and DCO Derek Murphy went into Room 013 in Eden wing which is located almost adjunct to the office this was approximately at 03:40 after a few minutes I heard noise coming from the room and made my way over there following DCO Alex Papworth. As I entered the room I saw that DCM Lyden had control of Detainee D1251 right arm, which they had gone to wake up and advise that he had a flight. I took control of the right arm and put Detainee D1251 into full locks, which is a home office approved technique as per my training. I saw that detainee D1251 had then spat out a blade which he had attempted to swallow, Detainee D1251 was then placed into hand cuffs, I had placed his hand behind his back in a hammer position still in locks and hand cuffs where then applied. After cuffs where applied as de-escalation Detainee D1251 had his head released and locks released.

Detainee D1251 was then guided to the detainee discharge area; I guided him using home office approved guiding holds. From there he was handed over to Tascor overseas crew and the hand cuffs where removed once they had taken control. A member of healthcare was present at the time and no injuries were received by myself. No more force was used than was necessary. This concludes my report.

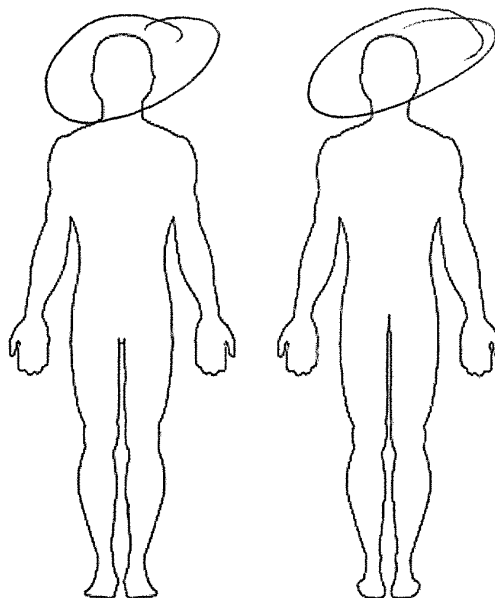

At approximately 03:45 on the 04/05/2017, I, DCO D. Murphy was on duty on E wing/CSU as a Detainee Custody Officer at Brook House IRC. I Was asked by DCM Andy Lyden to accompany him into room 013 on E wing where detainee D1251 CID 9835919 was housed. DCM Lyden had to inform D1251 that he had to go to departures where the Tascor escorts were waiting for him as he was going on a chartered flight to Albania. DCM Lyden instructed D1251 Several times to get out of his bed and go to departures. D1251 refused saying "I will swallow this blade, I am not going". D1251 then attempted to put another blade into his mouth; At that point I took control of D1251 head using home office approved techniques and assisted him to his feet. Handcuffs were then applied in an attempt to de-escalate the resistance, at that point I informed D1251 that I was going to release his head if he would walk compliantly to departures which he did. D1251 was still displaying resistance but kept walking. I then proceeded to escort D1251 to the departure area and handed him over to the waiting Tascor escorts. A member of healthcare was present throughout and voiced no concerns. No injuries were reported. No more force that necessary was used throughout this incident. That concludes my report.
