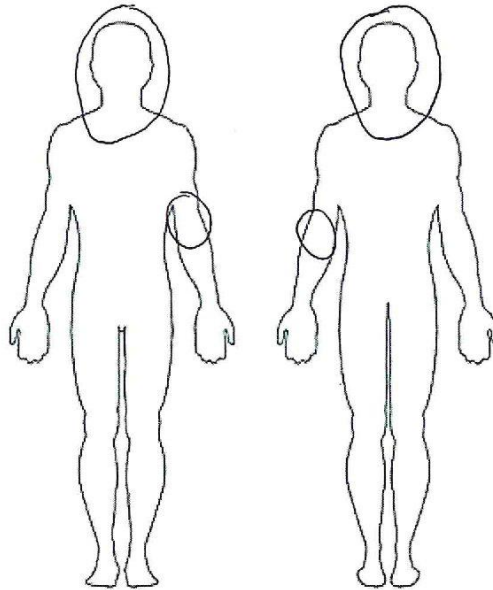

I Detainee Custody Officer (DCO) Ollie White was working at Brook House IRC, Perimeter Road South, Gatwick, RH6 0PQ on the 11/06/ 2017. Where I was involved in a Control & Restraint incident with Detainee [D1853]. I started my shift at 21:00 and carried out my usual duties as a DCO. I was called by the control room to be involved in the removal of [D1853] and pass him on to the TASCOR escorts that were going to escort [D1853] on a flight to the Netherlands. We got kitted up in a team of 4 officers; DCO Jonny Martin, DCO Andy Simmons and DCO Mohammed Shaukat. We were given the initial brief by Detainee Custody Manager (DCM) Chris Donnelly and were informed of the situation and our roles. I was given my primary role as Number 3 arm officer. We walked down to Beck Wing and waited outside room B/115 for further instruction. DCM Donnelly opened the door to which we saw [D1853] standing at the back of the room in front of the desk which is parallel to the back wall facing towards us. As DCM Donnelly asked [D1853] if he was going to walk down with us, he then proceeded to say "I've got razor blades in my mouth and I'm going to swallow them". At no point did I see any razor blades in the mouth of the detainee when he opened it and after being asked for a second time by DCM Donnelly, we were given instruction to advance into the room. We advanced in the room at 05:08. After the shield was placed on [D1853], I went to move round to the left arm to gain control of it. As I did this, [D1853] started to struggle, resist and began to fall down on his left side on to the bed. By doing this, it meant that DCO Shaukat had to move and take control of [D1853]'s left arm and I moved to take control of his head and become the Number 1 officer. My right forearm was across half of [D1853]'s face with my middle finger placed just under [D1853]'s bottom lip on the top side of his chin and my index finger placed just under the curvature of the bottom of his chin. I had my left arm across the top of his back and my left hand was placed on the bottom of the back of his head. After I had full control of his head, DCO Simmons placed the handcuffs on [D1853]. Once the cuffs were secure we began to move [D1853] out of the room. As the now Number 1 officer, I began to walk backwards out of the room. We rotated round out of the room door in order to get [D1853] out safely and in one fluent motion. Once complete, I proceeded to the top of the Control and Restraint staircase on Beck (B) Wing which goes down to the Care and Separation Unit (CSU) where the TASCOR escorts were waiting. Once at the top of the staircase we proceeded to move down the staircase. I still had [D1853] in the same position with him bent over so I had control but also at the right angle so he was still able to breathe and not restrict his airway. Just as we started moving down the staircase, I noticed that [D1853] had calmed down and was being compliant, to which he said that he would walk down without the need of his head being restrained. As he said this I explained that I would release hold of his head if he would walk to which he said "Yes". I released and we proceeded down the rest of the staircase. We entered the CSU at 05:11 to the awaiting TASCOR escorts. He wasn't taken by the TASCOR escorts due to them not having a nurse present with their escort team as he said he still had a blade in his mouth. Because of this he was placed into one of the CSU rooms at 05:16. The force that was used was reasonable and necessary. This concludes my report.

I, Detainee Custody Officer (DCO) Andy Simmons have worked at Brook House Immigration Removal Centre (BHIRC) since September 2014.

On Sunday 11th June 2017, I was on my 6th night shift in a row. At approximately 0430 I was told by Oscar One, Detainee Custody Manager (DCM1) Dave Alddis to collect my personal protective equipment and meet in the ground floor staff roof to take part in a planned Control and Restraint (C&R) removal.

Detainee **D1853** CID number 11224849 was refusing to leave room 115 on Bravo wing to meet Overseas Escorts for a flight to Holland. The team consisted of DCO's Martin, White and Shaukat. I was assigned as support officer and if necessary I would apply mechanical restraints.

The team were Briefed by DCM (Oscar 2) Chris Donnelly (DCM2) and we made our way to Bravo wing.

DCM 2 opened room 115 and asked the detainee to walk to meet the escorts. The detainee then shouted "I have fucking blades in my mouth, i have fucking blades". At this point, DCM 2 told the team to enter the room and take control of the detainee.

Once the team had gained control, I entered and placed the mechanical restraints on the detainee at approximately 05:09. I made sure that the restraints where not too tight and that they were not cutting into the detainees wrists.

We made our way down the C&R staircase at the back of Bravo wing to Care and Separation Unit (CSU), where the TASCOR Overseas escorts where waiting.

After discussions with the TASCOR Escorts, it was decided by then that they would not take the detainee for his flight. We then moved into CSU Room 4 where at approximately 05:16 i removed the restraints and left the room. The other officers then left the room and the detainee turned around and started laughing at us.

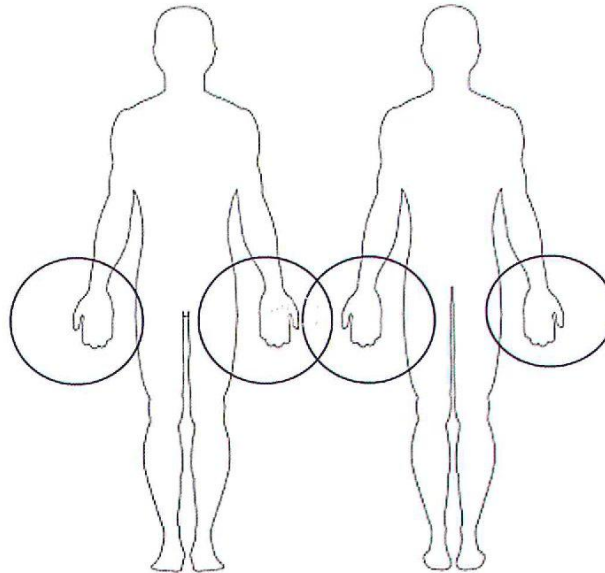

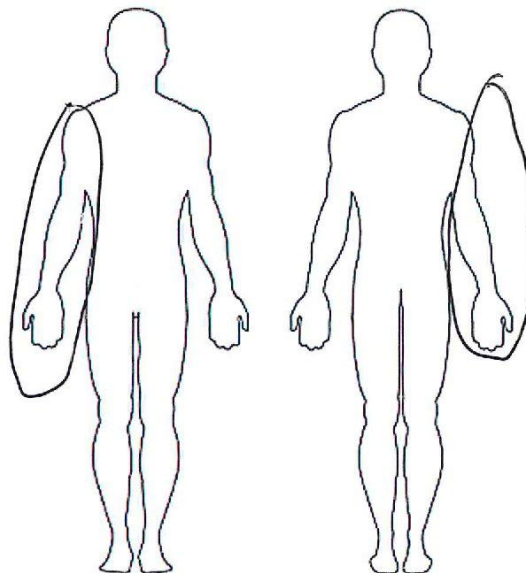

I DCO Jonathan Martin, am a DCO at Brook House Immigration Centre, a position I have held since September 2014. On 11/06/17, I was working at Brook House IRC as Echo 4 in reception. I was requested by Oscar One Dave Aldis to collect my PPE to assist with an Overseas Removal of [D1853] who was due to fly to the Netherlands.

At approximately 0510 we made our way to Bravo Wing room B/115, where [D1853] was residing. When we got to B/115, DCM Chris Donnelly asked [D1853] if he was going to comply by walking down to the escorts who were waiting in CSU, [D1853] said he wouldn't, so we instructed to enter B/115 and take control of [D1853]. My role was a number 2 officer, taking control of [D1853]'s right arm, when entering I took control of [D1853]'s right arm and he was assisted to the bed where I place his right arm into a "back hammer" position so handcuffs could be applied. Once they were applied, by DCO Andy Simmons, we assisted [D1853] off the bed and guided him out of the room and down the C&R stairwell down to CSU. Whilst guiding him down the C&R stairwell, I heard [D1853] stating he had blades in his mouth. Once we arrived in CSU, the escorts were waiting for [D1853], [D1853] stated to them he had blades and whilst doing so, I seen once fall out of his mouth on to the floor. Tascor stated they were refusing to take [D1853] to the airport because of this and we were then requested to guide [D1853] to CSU/04, when we arrived [D1853] was content he was not leaving and asked us if we wanted him to walk forward when the handcuffed were removed. The handcuffs were removed, I released my hold on [D1853] and then [D1853] walked forward and I exited the room. I didn't not receive any injuries in this incident and this concludes my report.

I detainee Custody Officer (DCO) Mohammad Sheharyar Shaukat was on duty on the 11/06/2017 on a eleven hour night Shift working at Brook House Immigration removal centre (IRC) where I have been working for approximately 4 months and am currently in ticket for my Control and Restraint. I as well as three other Officers, (DCO) Ollie, (DCO) Andy and (DCO) Johnny, were deployed for a planned removal by Detainee custody manager (DCM) Chris Donnely, at approximately 05:11 hours on B Wing. First, we were all briefed by DCM Mr Chris Donnely, and were told that our task was to remove **D1853** CID 11224849 from his room and present him to the Tascor escorts whom would be escorting him back to Netherlands. Upon arriving at **D1853** room, he was standing in the middle of his room next to a boiled kettle. The DCM asked **D1853** if he was willing to cooperate and walk with us to the discharge area where he would be taken by Tascor escorts for his flight. DCM Mr Chris Donnely asked **D1853** **D1853** for his cooperation. **D1853** replied "No, I have blades in my mouth. I am not going anywhere."

At this point, when DCM Mr Chris Donnely had given **D1853** many opportunities to comply, he decided that as **D1853** was showing no signs of cooperation, that we should advance into his room and forcibly remove him.

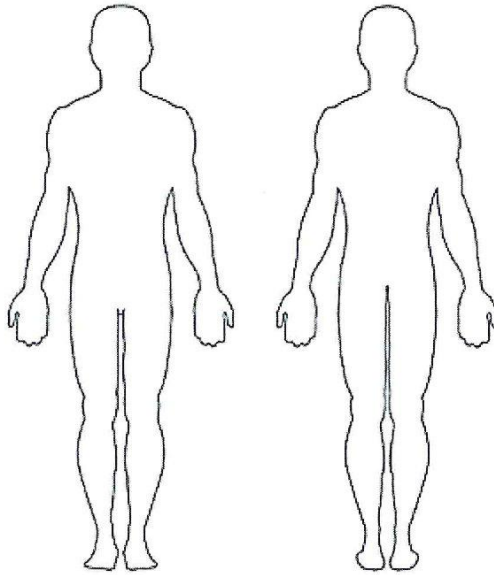
On DCM **D1853** command, I officer one (Shield officer) as well as officer two Ollie and Jonny the two arm officers entered the room. I then advanced into the room and placed the shield firmly on **D1853** to hold him against the wall for the safety of myself the staff and the detainee due to **D1853** **D1853** aggressive behavior. After the impact of the shield **D1853** slipped and landed on top of me on the bed. The shield was then removed and I then took control of **D1853** left arm, (DCO) Jonny then took control of the right arm and (DCO) Ollie took control of the head. Myself and Jonny then applied locks on the arms and guided them to **D1853** back so that (DCO) Andy could Apply the handcuffs on **D1853**. We then walked **D1853** down the hallway and onto the control and restraint staircase which is the staircase we use in a case of a use of force to ensure the safety of the detainee and staff.

As we were making our way down the staircase, I took the role of the support officer on **D1853** **D1853** Left Arm and we then slowly walked **D1853** down the stairs keeping his back



onto the wall to safeguard everyone involved. [D1853] was then presented to Tascor in the CSU at approximately 05:11 hours. Where Tascor fully searched [D1853] and found a blade in his mouth. [D1853] was asked by Tascor why he has a blade in his mouth, which [D1853] replied "I was being lazy before, I now have a lawyer and I don't want to go back". Due to [D1853] having a blade in his mouth Tascor refused to take him as they did not have a nurse present. [D1853] was then placed in CSU room 4 under the instruction of DCM Chris Donnelly.

I sustained no Injuries. This Concludes my Report.

Briefing Script

Introduction:

I am DCM Chris Donnelly

It is 0500 hrs, on 11/06/2017

The current situation is that detainee: **D1853**

Currently in: B/115

Has escorted removal directions to The Netherlands this morning with Tascor Over Seas escorts. After speaking with **D1853** he has refused several requests to walk compliantly with us to meet with Tascor stating his solicitor has told him to stay here.

D1853 has been in prison for **Sensitive/Irrelevant**. He has a history of poor custodial behaviour, assaults, threats and fighting.

He has previously refused to transfer for removal directions in April 2017

The Plan:

I will go to the room with a team of officers in full PPE. Entry to the room will be facilitated by myself and I will explain to **D1853** again that he has a flight this morning and that I need him to get up and come with me to meet with the escorts.

Due to his history of disruptive behaviour if he refuses this instruction or raises any suspicions that he may try to disrupt this removal from in his room I will immediately send the team in to gain control of him to prevent any disruption he may attempt.

IF force is used once under control hand cuffs if needed will be applied by the support officer.

The relocation point will be CSU association area. We will use the C and R stair case at the end of Bravo wing to liaise with Tascor.

I have selected a team of officers who are currently certificated in the Use of Force to carry out the intervention and I have identified them for their roles. They are:

Number One Officer: DCO M. Slanket

Number Two Officer: DCO J. Martin

Number Three Officer: DCO O. White

Support officer: DCO A. Simmons

They will now introduce themselves to the camera stating their rank, name and that they have no injuries and are currently certificated in the use of force.

The camera operator for this intervention is: DCM Dave Aldis

The healthcare official attending the intervention will now confirm to the camera their name, qualification and any medical concerns relevant to the detainee. (Grace)

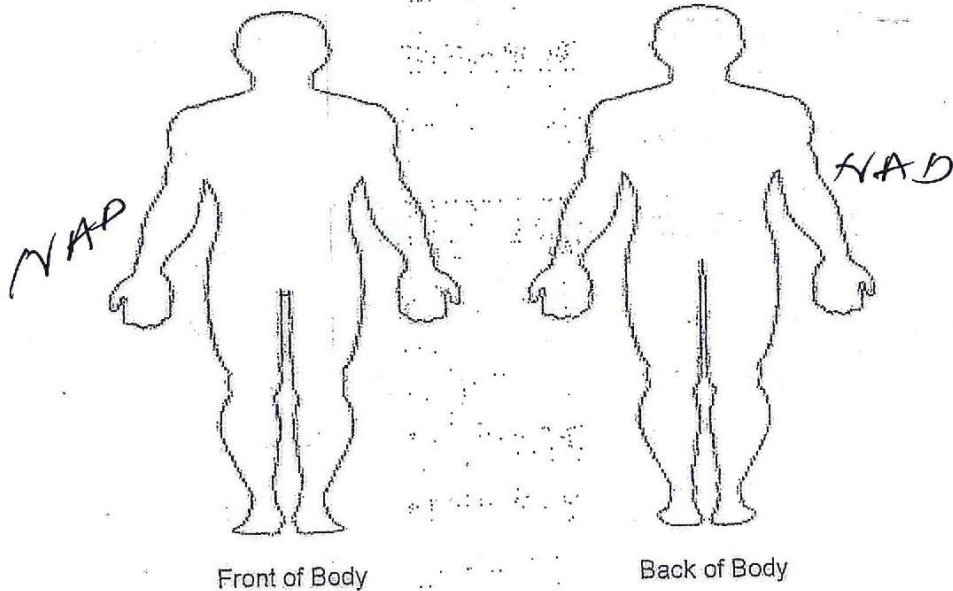
