I detained Custody Officer Joseph Marshall was on duty at Brook House Immigration Removal Centre on the 22nd May 2017. On this date I was completing a shift that starts at 0700 and ends at 1930. I was undertaking my duties as a Detainee Custody officer on this date. This is a role that I have fulfilled for seven and a half years, Since January 2010. At around 1630 on the fore mentioned date I was asked by Detainee Custody Manger David Aldis to base myself in the visits corridor from 1645 onwards. At around 1645 hours I was asked by DCM Aldis to accompany him and Detainee Custody officers Derek Murphy and Benjamin Wright to a visits corridor interview room to have a talk with detainee! D52 Once I entered this interview room I stood on the right hand side of a table and chairs that is fitted to the floor. Mr D52 was sat on one of these fitted chairs towards the rear of the room. DCM Aldis sat opposite Mr D52 Whilst DCO's Derek Murphy and Benjamin Wright were stood to the left of these fitted tables and chairs. I estimate this room to be around 4 metres by 6 metres in size. After a very brief period of entering this room DCM Aldis entered dialogue with Mr D52 1 can clearly remember DCM Aldis informing Mr D52 that due to his planned removal directions he needed to accompany all members of staff that were present in this room to Eden wing at Brook House IRC. This was in order to facilitate his removal directions. This period of dialogue lasted around five minutes. Towards the end of this it was becoming clear that Mr D52 was starting to become increasingly agitated in his demeanour. Mr D52 was beginning to raise his voice and pump his fists on the table that was in front of him. DCM Aldis then asked Mr. D52 on more than one occasion to walk to Eden wing with all present. Mr. D52 was once again raising his voice and appeared to be very agitated. DCM Aldis made it clear to Mr D52 that as an absolute last resort force may be used to relocate Mr D52 to Eden wing. Mr D52 continued to gesticulate with his hands and raise his voice, stating "I will only go to C wing, you are bullies and cannot move me anywhere". DCM Aldis then once again asked Mr. D52 to make his way to Eden wing. Mr. D52 reacted very aggressively to this and began pumping the table once more. Due to Mr Alabis now clearly aggressive behaviour DCM D52 stood up, stepped away from Mr D52 and instructed myself DCO Joseph Marshall, DCO Benjamin Wright and DCO Derek Murphy to assist Mr D52 to his feet. I then stepped towards Mr D52 whilst being extremely close to the fitted table and chairs, which were on my right side at this point. I then attempted to gain control of Mr D52 left arm. I had to slightly bend down to do this as Mr; D52 was in a seating position.





I placed both my ands of Mr D52 left arm, the Very instant I done this I could feel extreme resistance from Mr D52 Due to this Mr D52 was assisted from the chair he was sat in to the floor. During doing this I struck my left chest area against the table or chair and ended in a position where I was taying on my left side on the floor, attempting to gain control of Mr. D52 left arm. Mr. D52 was extremely resistant to this and for a short period I had hold of his arm whilst it was somewhat thrashing around the area beneath the fitted table and chairs. During this time, whilst still attempting to control Mr. D52 left arm I felt a sharp pain in my mid back region on the left side, I then moved my body further beneath the fitted tables and chairs. I was now partially beneath the tables and chairs, as was Mr D52 left arm. Due to the nature of the incident unfolding I could feel a slight adrenaline rush and as a result no major pain was apparent from my back region at this point. I was however well aware that I had previously felt a sharp pain in that region. After a brief period of attempting to lay Mt D52 aft arm on the floor in a fixed straight position I managed to do this. Due to the continued resistance I had been feeling from Mr. D52 i moved my body position and was now knelt upwards right next to the table and chairs with both hands holding Mri. D52 jeft arm to the floor. MI. D52 jeft arm was in a fixed straight position at this point. Once I was knelt over Mr D52 left arm it became apparent to me that a sharp stinging pain was emanating from my mid back region on my left hand side. The resistance I was feeling from Mr. D52 began to abate somewhat at this time. I did however instantly realise that Mr. D52 had my keys in his left hand. This must be due to the fact that during the struggle that had ensued my keys had fallen out of my key pouch, which was fitted to my belt around my waist. I gave a clear command at this point for Mr. D52 to let go of my keys immediately. Mr. D52 was screaming words that I was unable to understand at this point, although offering little resistance through his left arm. I once again instructed Mr. p52 to release my keys from his grip, he once again refused to do this so I very quickly applied a thumb lock to Mr. D52 left handed thumb and as a result he instantly released my keys from his grasp. I was now knelt over Mr D52 left arm with my right hand on Mr. D52 wrist and my left hand securing Mr D52 left arm to the ground. At this point I could feel no resistance from Mr! <u>D52</u> and this continued for a brief period. It was becoming more apparent to me that there was a sharp stinging pain emitting from my mid back region on the left side. Due to this I then turned my head around, looking towards the exit of the room and informed DCM David Aldis that I believed I had been bitten and was feeling a sharp stinging paid in my mid back region on the left side. DCO Gary hedge was stood next to DCM Aldis at this time, DCO Hedge then began to step towards us, so I asked DCO hedge if he could take over the control of Mr D52 left arm. This was due to the stinging pain I was feeling and my emotional state being affected. At this point I had a feeling of fear that I can only associate with receiving a human bite. For example the potential to become infected with various mouth born viruses etc. I did not release my hands from Mr. D52 left arm until DCO Gary Hedge was in a position to continue. DCO Gary Hedge got himself into a position to secure Mr D52 arm to the floor. At no point during the process of this was Mi. D52 left arm not secured to the floor. Once DCO Gary Hedge had done this I stood up and exited the room. Upon exiting the room I lifted my shirt and showed my lower back area to a member of the Brook House healthcare department that was stood outside, they immediately advised me to attend the healthcare clinic located within Brook House. I then proceeded to do this and as a result had no further involvement in this incident. As a result of this incident! have sustained a bite mark to my lower back region on the left side, this has punctured the skin and as a result I had to attend East Surrey Hospital accident and emergency department. 
On the 22/05/2017 I was working at Brook House in the Visits Hall when I got asked to walk D52 down to E wing after Oscar 1 DCM Dave Aldis informed he was being taken down there due to the threats he made about him not going on the charter flight tomorrow. In the Room was myself DCO Derick Murphy, DCO Joe Marshall and DCM Dave Aldis. Mr. D52 was in interview room 4 when we were speaking to him. Mr. D52 wasn't being compliant and wasn't letting Dave explain the reason he was being taken to E wing but just shouting he isn't moving until he spoke to his lawyer. After being given many chances to walk down to E wing it was decided we would have to take him by force at around 16:50 as myself and Derick Murphy moved around the table to take control of his arms My D52! forced himself to the floor screaming and kicking so officers couldn't move towards luckily I got hold his right arm and pinned it to the floor securing it. Derick got hold of the head whilst Joe crawled under the table to gain control of his left arm and DCM Dean Brackenbridge came in from outside and took control of the legs after that I saw Joe Marshall being pulled out by Dave Aldis and taken over by DCO Garry Hedge I later discovered this was because joe had been bitten in the back and needed medical assistance. We then moved Mr. D52 into the inverted hold and he sat up. As he sat up we then moved his hand behind his back and Dave Aldis applied handcuffs. Mri. <u>D52</u> then started to comply and would walk down to CSU. Derick Released the head and Mr. D52 stood up supported by myself and Garry. He then walked down to CSU with no issues being constantly supported by the officers was relocated into CSU around 17:00 with no issues. I know of no injuries that I sustained from this incident and the time of writing this report, this concludes my report to the best of my knowledge.

I was asked by Oscar one(1) to accompany him to an interview room in the visits area because detainee Mr. D52 D52 CID 685502 had made threats that he was going to final tomorrow if they try remove him on the charter flight. DCM Aldis informed Mr. D52 that he would be moved to E wing because of these threats. After several requests form DCM Aldis Mr D52 became very volatile and refused. He started flaying his arms around. I took control of Mt D52 s head using home office approved techniques and lowered him to the floor in a safe and controlled manner. Mri D52 was lying on his back; At that point I assisted Mr. D52 into the sitting position, DCM Aldis then handed me a set of handcuffs which I applied to de-escalate the level of aggression that i.__052._i was showing. I then assisted Mr. D52! onto his feet. I then instructed Mr. D52! to walk compliantly to CSU which he did. I then instructed Mr. D52! to stand facing the window while I removed the handcuffs, which he did. I removed the handcuffs and left the room in a controlled and safe manner. 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

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
