Reason(s) Non compliance with request to speak to escorts for a suitable move to Harmondsworth. D390 had been spoken to about the move and the last conversation was that he would no go and walk to speak to the escorts. He was explained our duty was to produce him to the escorts and if we have to use force this would happen at a last resort. Immigration had been contacted in regards to comments he made about a legal judicial review and a bail hearing. On site immigration Heenaxi Patel contacted DEPMU and the move would still have to go ahead for an asylum interview which he states he doesn't want to do. Despite this and being told his bail hearing would still go ahead the circumstances dictated a call to use force. His room mate D1851 CID: 11221714 refused to leave the room after being asked and D390 was seen boiling a kettle of water.

I Detainee Custody Manager (DCM) Ben Shadbolt, I am currently employed by G4S Care and Justice Services at Brook House Immigration removal centre a position I have had for 5 years 10 months. I was on shift when at the time of 16:30 I DCM Shadbolt when I was asked by DCM Nick London to collect my Personal Protective Equipment for a planned intervention. In the briefing it was explained that detainee that I know to be D390 CID REF: 4334627 as he was due to transfer to Harmondsworth IRC and had previously refused and all negotiations had be exhausted and that the planned intervention was the last resort. I was selected to be part of a three man team those other officer being DCO Sean Sayers as number one shield officer and DCO Ryan Bromley and myself as arm officers. Once the briefing was completed we then made our way to Alpha wing room 209 upon arriving outside of the room DCM Stewart Povey began to talk to D390 through the viewing panel and was seen to be boiling a kettle inside the room to which, there was also water on the floor outside the door. It appeared as if the kettle had been boiled a numerous amount of times, as you could see a large amount of steam from outside the room. We were then instructed to enter the room to which D390 was first standing next to the kettle but was contained between the wall and the shield and now sitting on the bed I DCM Ben Shadbolt then took control of D390 left arm first putting it in to a inverted wrist hold I done this by placing my right arm on the inside of D390 left arm cocking his wrist and placing my left hand on to the top of his left forearm blocking his elbow with my body announcing "lock on" I then transferred to D390 left hand to the lower part of his back maintaining the wrist lock where D390 was then escorted outside of the room at this time the intervention was de-escalated to guiding hold where I DCM Shadbolt then placed my right hand on to D390 left elbow and placed my left hand on to the top of D390 left forearm where he then compliantly walked with us down the staircase with his back to the wall to the suitable crew awaiting for him at the bottom of Alpha wing control and restraint staircase where he was then presented to the escorts.

This concludes my report.

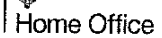




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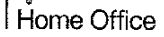

I Detainee Custody Manager Stewart Povey-Meier was working in my role as a residential manager on my first day of shift when at around 15:00 on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> June 2017 I was informed by DCo Eshmail Moshari that detainee **D390** had an escorted move to Harmondsworth that was with a suitable crew. Detainee **D390** was informed by DCO Ben Opoku upon my instructions of the move. The detainee then came to me to explain that at the weekend he had been told to move and was packed ready to go but on advise from his solicitor he has been told to stay at Brook House stating that he had legal representation in the up[per Tribunal court to stay at Brook House. When asked if he had a copy of this he said on Friday he gave this to the TASCOR escorts that had come to collect him. He also stated to me that he had bail on Friday and didn't want to move. At this point the Upper Tribunal were contacted by **D390** and I spoke to them direct. They refused to send any paperwork other than a fax stating he had a judicial review in place but not the contents as he should have this because it was sent to him on 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2017. **D390** then contacted the Bail court and they did say that he had a hearing on Friday at Taylor House and immigration would be informed tomorrow of this. I then spoke to Heenaxi Patel of onsite immigration and she made some phone calls with this information and then made me aware that the move would still go ahead and if he didn't want to claim asylum as he had stated in previous conversation that he needs to tell them that and request to transfer back. They would ensure wherever he is they would make sure his bail hearing is facilitated at Harmondsworth. When told this information and he said it sounds sensible but will take his solicitor advise and when asked if he would walk with us to speak with the escorts he said no. Tascor escorts where explained of the situation and they said they would wait until our roll count time when detainees would be behind their doors. A team was assembled in preparation of any planned C&R intervention. The circumstances was that there were two detainees situated in room A/209 one being **D390** who was situated in left hand bed as you

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look into the room, and detainee [D1851]. The team were briefed of the circumstances of why a planned C&R may take place and that [D390] would get a further opportunity to walk with the team to meet the escorts that would be at the bottom of the Arun Wing C&R stairwell as this was deemed the safest and quickest route to handover. The team was split into two DCO Sean Sayers, DCO Ryan Bromley and DCM Ben Shadbolt were to be the team looking after [D390] and cuff officer was DCO Caillum Tulley. DCO Darren Bulled, DCM Shane Farrell, and DCO Neil Timms were to look after [D1851]. Healthcare were present with Eavan Owen, and Carol Reed both nurses present, and DCM Nick London was the camera operator. Upon approaching room A/209 it was noticed that the floor outside the room had a puddle of water. When looking into the room from the flap on the door the sink did not show anything of risk to the team. Detainee [D1851] was in bed and appeared to be watching television. Detainee [D390] was seen in the middle of the room at the back by the desk and was boiling a kettle of water with the lid open. Detainee [D1851] was asked to come to the door which he did and asked to leave the room when the door opened. He refused to do this and said that he wasn't leaving the room and proceeded to return to the bed. Due to the circumstances of the kettle being boiled and the refusal of the room mate to comply. Both teams assembled outside the door and explained where the detainees were in the room. Previously they had been shown a picture of the two detainees to know who was who. The teams were instructed to take control of the situation based on the circumstances and that [D390] had previously been given reasonings of the move and assisted by staff to try and help. Both teams went in, force was used on [D390] and removed from the room and his head was released as he wanted to comply and walk to the TASCOR team, this was done via the agreed route. Detainee [D1851] had no forced used and the team were present to make sure he did not put anyone's safety at risk including his own. [D390] was moved down the C&R stairwell on A-wing from second floor to the ground floor and presented to the TASCOR team who discussed with him his reasons about the move. On debrief no one was injured during the restraint. Healthcare were not concerned of any injuries. Detainee [D1851] was met with afterwards and appeared calm and had no issues with what had happened. This concludes my report.





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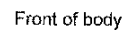

I (DCO) Detainee custody officer, Ryan Bromley employed by G4S care and justice services at Brook House immigration centre, am in ticket and fully trained in C+R and first aid.

On the 5<sup>th</sup> of June 2017 at approximately 16:30 I was asked to assemble my personal protection equipment and be briefed for a planned relocation of detainee D390 (4434627). DCM Stuart Povey was in charge of the briefing which myself DCO Ryan Bromley, DCO Neil Timms, DCO Sean Sayers, DCO Darren Bulled, DCM Shane Farrel, DCM Ben Shadbolt attended.

During the brief it was confirmed that myself and DCO Sean Sayers, DCM Ben Shadbolt would be team 1 with DCO Sayers being the head officer, and myself and DCM Shadbolt being arm officers.

At Approximately 17:00 we made our way from the staff room to which the brief was being held, to the location of detainee D390, which was AWING room209. Once the team arrived at the door of AWING room209, DCM Povey had begun to give D390 instructions through the closed door and immediately noticed D390 repeatedly boiling his kettle in his room with the room's floor already gathering a puddle. D390 continued to ignore instructions given but moved to face the door of the room. Immediately the team were instructed to advance into AWING room209 with myself and DCO Shadbolt closely following DCO Sayers in. Upon entering detainee D390 continued to ignore instructions from DCO Sayers, for the safety of the team DCO Sayers advanced placing the shield onto detainee D390 chest, placing him onto the bed on the rooms left side. Immediately I took control of detainee's left arm while DCO Shadbolt took control of his right arm. DCO Sayers then began to give detainee D390 instructions to how we'd exit the room, to which D390 complied. Guiding holds were then placed onto the detainee as we lead him towards the nearest exit of the wing. Once at the top of staircase DCO Sayers then began to give instructions on how we'd go down the stair case to which detainee D390 fully complied and a team from TASCOR were waiting to transport the detainee.



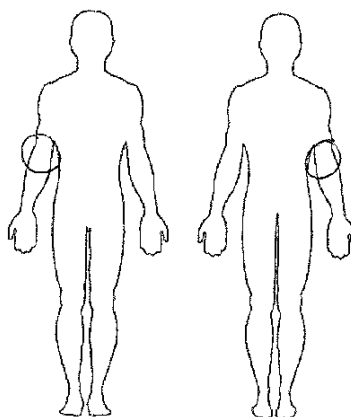

[D390], placing him onto the bed on the right hand side of the room. DCO Shadbolt and Bromley were then able to take control of [D390] arms and place them to the bottom of his back in locked position. Once I saw that DCO Shadbolt and Bromley had full control of [D390], I removed the shield. From here I advised DCO Shadbolt and Bromley to move in to finally lock and began communication with [D390]. I explained that he would be walking with us to the Tascor escorting officers. Once we had left the room I could see that [D390] was being compliant with me and had listened to all instructions I had given him so the arm officers released the locks down to guiding holds. Once we reached the C+R staircase we placed [D390] against the wall for his safety with officers still in the guiding hold position and I was stood in front of him continuing communication until we met the Tascor escorts at the bottom of the staircase.

I believed that the force used was necessary and proportionate for the situation we were faced with.

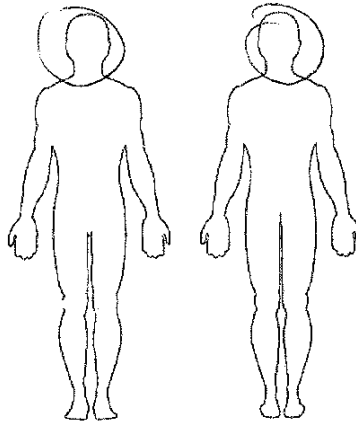
I (DCO) Sean Sayers was asked to collect my personal protection equipment for a planned removal of detainee: D390 (4334627)

DCM (Detainee Custody Manager) Stuart Povey conducted the briefing for the teams. Team 1 consisted of DCO Sayers, DCO Shadbolt and DCO Bromley, team 2 consisted of DCM Farrell, DCO Builed and DCO Timms. Also present was 2 members of the onsite health care team and recording the C+R DCM London. In the briefing it was explained that detainee D390 (4334627) had refused to leave the centre and was willing to fight officers that entered the room. It was explained to us that D390 would be given 1 finally chance to walk compliantly to the escorting officers and if he refused to walk then the team would be asked to enter to the room in order to present him to the escorts.

As we approached the room on level 2, room 209 Alpha Wing there was a puddle of water right at the entrance of the room. DCM Povey lifted the observation flap, D390 was stood at the far end of the room next to the desk next to the kettle. He appeared to be boiling the kettle. DCM Povey gave us a signal to enter the room. The team lead by DCO Sayers on the shield and DCO Shadbolt and Bromley as arm officers entered the room. D390 continued to stand at the far end of the room next to the desk and kettle. D390 didn't listen to me asking him to sit on the bed as I entered the room. I feared that myself and the team could be covered in boiling water I advanced with the team and placed the shield onto the chest of
