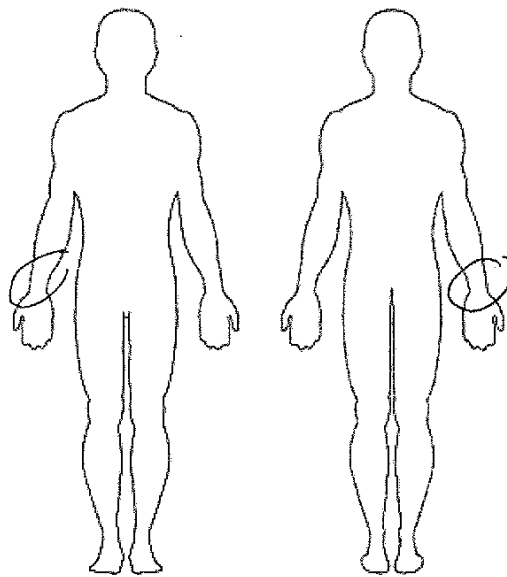

I am Detainee Custody Manager Shane Farrell. I am currently employed by G4S care and justice services at Gatwick Immigration removal Centre, A position that I have had for 6 years and 5 months. On the 31/07/2017 at approximately 14:08 force was used on **D2734** CID REFF: 12268405 because of his threatening behaviour towards another detainee. At around 12:08 force was used to relocate **D2734** to our Care and separation unit 001. I helped Detainee Custody Officer (DCO) Leo Sherwood gain control Of **D2734** by holding onto his right arm then I positioned myself so that I could gain control **D2734** right wrist once I did this I was able to put **D2734** into final locks once this was done myself and DCO L Sherwood walked him while in final locks to our Care and Separation Unit (CSU). When we entered room 001 DCO Andy Jennings conducted a level A search and found that he did not have any thing on his person he sat on his bed and the locks where released as he was. In my eyes the use of force was Proportionate and reasonable in the circumstance. This concludes my report at this time.

I am Detainee Custody Officer Leo Sherwood, I am currently employed by G4S care and Justice services at Tinsley House, a position I have had for 2 years and 3 months. I am in Ticket and fully trained in C&R and First aid trained. I currently have no injuries.

On the day of the 31/07/17 I was working on Echo wing at brook house immigration centre, In Echo wing room 006 was detainee **D2734** Throughout the morning **D2734** had been staying in his room and was in need of help with certain things to which I was helping him with, like getting welfare to see him and trying to source a TV. He was also demanding a cigarette and saying he needs one Now, I could not help him with this and he was becoming frustrated.

It is also worth noting that he is on a ACDT care plan from Morton Hall IRC due to not wanting to return to Spain on the 1/8/17.

Throughout the day **D2734** has been disruptive and rude towards staff by setting fire to parts of his room and refusing to give over his lighter which he was hiding on himself, also took the pool cue and was attempting to smash the sprinkler system in his room.

At approximately 1405 hours I was sitting in the Echo wing office writing up some ACDT'S and a detainee approached the wing office and said " big problem down the wing" so I left the office shortly followed by DCM Shane Farrell and DCO Kerry Copping and as I walked down the wing I saw detainee **D1020** sitting on the computer and **D2734** standing next to him and was in an aggressive stance and was saying things **D1020** in a loud tone, at that point **D2734** stood up and I managed to shout get back and assist **D2734** away from **D1020** however **D2734** refused to give up and continued to try and go for **D1020** at this point I noticed a red pool ball in **D2734**'s hand and I managed to take it away from him, **D2734** was then getting angry with me and started to threaten me but then picked up the dustpan, I believe that **D2734** was looking for a weapon to use against either **D1020** or myself or a staff member, **D2734** and **D1020** continued to shout at each other in their own languages and the situation was not calming down, **D2734** still continued to push past me and go for **D1020** and was becoming more and more aggressive, at approximately 1408 **D2734** lunged towards me in a very aggressive way.

and I had no option but to use force and took hold of [D2734] by wrapping my arms around the top half of his body and assisted him towards the wall next to the CSU door, at this point DCM Shane Farrell intervened and took control of [D2734] right arm and then I took control of his left arm by holding [D2734] left arm straight and then into a final lock position, he offered a little resistance at first but then little after that, DCM Shane Farrell told him that he is now going into CSU on Rule 40, so the gate into CSU was opened and we assisted [D2734] remaining in final lock into CSU and into Room 001, upon entering [D2734] was being verbally aggressive and was shouting towards [D1020]. He was given a search By DCO Andy Jennings and continued to be disruptive towards the search however the search was completed and we sat down on the bed still remaining in final locks, once sat down we attempted to de-escalate the situation by asking him to calm down, which he did and then reduced our final locks to guiding holds as he had calmed down a lot more, DCM Shane Farrell then spoke with [D2734] and explained that he will be staying in this room for the time being. I was then asked to leave the room, which I did safely and securely and once we all left safely the door was closed.

I believe that the force used was reasonable to the circumstance and no more force was used than necessary to help protect himself and everybody around him due to his aggressive and threatening behaviour.

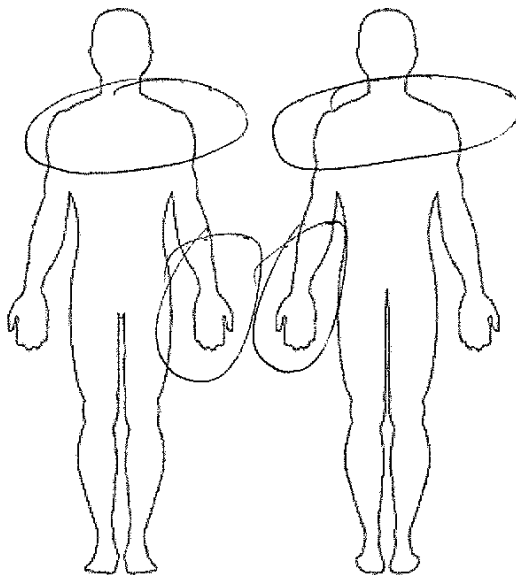
