The plan is to go to C 011 and speak to D1914 this is a disabled room and he is currently on the right bed and the view will be obstructed by the shower curtains. D1914 also has a room mate a D2401 who is a paid worker.
Due to D1914 refusal and previous self harm the door will be opened the first team will go in and stand by D1914 bed with myself behind talking to D1914 At this point the second team will instruct D2401 to come out of the room supervised by DCM S Loughton / S Farrell
alerted us to the fact D1914 has brought some Spice and his plan is to smoke it so that he dies or ends up in hospital to stop his removal directions another reason why this move cannot wait. D2401 has been spoken to and he wants nothing to do with these issues and has stated he will not become involved, however we have 2 teams in PPE just in case one for Mr D1914
D1914 has a significant history of previous self harm. He also has medical issues to do with his heart. He has previously had a heart attack and a double heart bypass in November, he also has medical letters to say he is due another operation in August. We have liaised closely with our onsite Healthcare and in
particular Dr Hussain who has stated and written a letter

D1914 is fit to be detained, fit to fly and fit to have confirming force used on him. We will have Healthcare present throughout and also the medical evac chair, this will purely be for if D1914 becomes complaint and requires medical assistance by way of the chair to Eden Wing. D1914 will have a full search in CSU this will be done compliantly, however if not and he is unwilling to comply then this will also be done under force. Once completed and sterile then he will be placed into Eden Wing 007. A full search has been authorised by: S Skitt I have selected a team of officers who are currently certificated in the Use of Force to carry out the intervention and I have identified them for their roles. They are: Number One Officer: DCO I Piscalli Number Two Officer: DCO D Webb Number Three Officer: DCO C Tulley Support Officer(s) DCO A Wragg Support Officer(s) DCO S Savers Support Officer(s) DCO J Edon Support Officer(s) DCO R Bromley Support Officer(s) DCO D Lake They will now introduce themselves to the camera stating their rank, name and that they have no injuries and are currently certificated in the use of force. Detention Custody Manager { DCM } S Dix was working at Brook House IRC on Saturday 27/05/2017 when a planned intervention was required on D1914 11382233 due to his non-compliance due to co-operate with his Escorted Removal Directions 28/05/2017. Despite negotiations by myself and DCO S Sayers during the daytime D1914 refused to comply and walk compliantly, please see attached briefing script for further details. The plan was to go to D1914 room C Wing 011 and one team of officers and Personal Protective Equipment {PPE} went in to stand in front of D1914 and the second team of officers went in to secure his room mate D2401						
The door was opened and this is what happened D2401 left the room compliantly and as this was going on D1914 held his chest and laid on his side on the bed, due to his ongoing medical concerns I requested healthcare to check him over they did this and were nappy with his medical observations and for the removal to continue. The removal continued and D1914 A stood off the bed and then dropped his body weight as he went to the floor he officers supported him, but he was refusing to stand up again when officers tried to assist him as well as verbally refusing to comply.						
t was explained to him if he continued this way then handcuffs would be applied and cotentially he would be carried down to Eden Wing, D1914 refused to engage or comply so I DCM S Dix made the decision for handcuffs to be applied. At this point Mr D1914 became resistant and non-compliant and resisted against officers, once officers pained control of D1914 handcuffs were applied by DCO A Wragg and checked and secured by myself.						


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Once they were secured D1914 stated he would comply so he stood up and was assisted by officers to his feet and left compliantly and walked compliantly to Eden Wing. Once we arrived to Eden wing he walked into room 007 where the handcuffs were removed by myself. I DCM S Dix took the left handcuff off followed by his right one.
As this was done D1914 was aware he would need to comply with a full search to which he agreed. D1914 removed his flip flops which were searched, he then removed his shorts and boxers which were searched and he placed his boxers back on and nothing was found. Healthcare then checked him over following the removal and stated they were happy, officers left the room and he was placed onto DC Rule 40 due to his non-compliance and to facilitate his removal directions. An ACDT was also opened and he was placed onto a Constant Supervision due to his previous self-harm history.
This concludes my report.




On the 27th May 2017 I Dco Dave Webb Whilst working at Brook House IRC on Eden Wing was contacted by Dcm Steve Loughton via the telephone and informed that I would be taking part in a planned intervention that involved moving Detainee from Charlie wing room C011 to Eden Wing Room E007 I was D1914 asked to get my PPE and meet in the staff room for 20:50hrs for the briefing prior to the intervention. On arrival at the staff when the team and healthcare representatives had arrived Dcm Steve Dix gave the briefing stating that two teams where to enter room C011 and that Detainee D1914 was in the right hand bed and that the team that I was part of was to enter the room once Dcm Dix had opened the door and we were to move to a position in front of the bed blocking Detainee D1914 exit from the room whilst a second teem entered directly behind us to remove Detainee D1914 room mate from the left hand bed leaving my team to escort [] D1914 from his room and relocate him into room E007 where we were told that he would be having a full search due to intelligence received about Detainee D1914 We were also informed that D1914 had history of a previous heart attack and had undergone a heart operation in the past we were also shown a signed letter from the Doctor that stated that D1914 Was fit to fly and that C&R techniques could be used on the Detainee. When the briefing was completed we made our way to Charlie wing and formed up outside room C011 at approximately 21.15 hrs Dcm Dix opened the door and the teams entered the room as we stood in front of Detainee D1914 who was sitting on his bed he placed his right arm to his chest and collapsed side ways onto the bed into the recovery position we immediately called in healthcare and they entered the room to examine the detainee as soon as they started communicating with him he became responsive and sat up at this point I held his left arm in a guiding hold holding his arm away from his chest so that the healthcare team could continue to examine him unimpeded by myself once healthcare confirmed that they were happy with us to carry on Dcm Dix tried to explained to D1914 that we needed him to walk with us to Eden wing D1914 became more agitated at this and started to become more volatile I then moved his arm into a final lock position and we tried to stand him up



as we did this D1914 dropped his whole body weight to the floor and became more resistant after a short time of period of time Dcm Dix gave the order to use handcuffs due to the level of resistance from D1914 as I moved his arm round into a loose back hammer so that the handcuffs could be applied the level of resistance from the detainee escalated and I moved his arm into a straight arm lock to maintain better control of his arm and the handcuffs were applied to his right wrist first then I repositioned his arm into a loose back hammer in the small of back straight into the handcuffs. Once the handcuffs were applied Dcm Dix continued to converse with D1914 and deescalate the situation after a short period of time D1914 had Deescalated enough that we could get him to his feet and we then escorted him out of the room and walked him of the wing through the sterile area and into Eden wing stopping in room E007 all the time supporting the detainee for his own safety as he was in handcuffs. As we walked D1914 was continually shouting abuse at the officers and also racial abuse directed at the healthcare nurses. Once we were in room E007 I was replaced by Dco Edon and I took no further part in the C&R or in the searching of the Detainee. I was told that due to his violent history and the fact that he stated to Managers he would obstruct and intended to fight Staff this is why a team was put together. I was also told that detained D1914 had a history of heart problems, therefor health care was present to Monitor his heart. Also a doctor had seen detained D1914 and wrote a letter to state he was fit and well and if Cond R was needed it could be Carried out. On entering the room with the team detained D1914 was sitting on his bed, he was instructed walk with us to E-wing. on his heal. Health core immediately checked his blood pressure and carried out checks. Health core told is he was fine. We once as un expland detained D1914 he had to walk to Ewing. He refused and sat on the floor. At this point I took control of his left arm, and placed him under restraint with the fear. Hand cuffs were applied and detained D1914 walked to E-wing with guiding hold technique. Detainee D1914 was verbaly and racially abusine to all staff and the health care team. On arrival to Cruin detainer D1914 walked into 100m 007. I was then relieved by DCO Bromley and I left the room. Force was only used when recessory and no more force was used than recessary at all times. Only home office approved techniques were Used. This Concludes my report DCO Paschah.





I Jonathan Edon work as a DCO (Detainee Custody Officer) at Brook House Gatwick Immigration Removal Centre, a position that I have held since January 2017. On Saturday 27 th May I was asked by Oscar 1 DCM Steve Loughton to be part of a control and Restraint team to assist in the relocation of Detainee D1914 (CID: 11382233) from Charlie Wing room C011 to Echo Wing room E007 as he was due to be removed from Brook House the following day.							
I was tasked on being part of the second of two teams along with DCO Sean Sayers, DCO Ryan Bromley and DCO Daniel Lake to ensure that Detainee D1914 roommate Detainee D2401 (CID: 12117070) did not get involved in any way and become an obstruction.							
At approximately 2130hrs both teams entered room C011. Detained D2401 was compliant and was walked immediately by the second team to the Delta Wing office where here remained with us until Detainee D1914 had been relocated to Echo Wing.							
I was then asked to go to Echo Wing where I was instructed to enter room E007 with DCO Ryan Bromley whilst D1914 handcuffs were being removed by DCM Steve Dix. During this time I supported D1914 right arm while his handcuffs were being removed without issue.							
On the removal of the cuffs D1914 was given a full search with a towel being used to cover his lower half. His shorts were searched by myself and found to contain nothing. With the search complete DCM Dix, DCO Bromley and I exited the room.

My name is Detainee Custody Officer (DCO) Callum Tulley and I have been working live at Brook House Immigration Removal Centre, Perimeter Road South, RH6 OPQ live since the 15th of June 2015.

At approximately 2100 I was told to get into my Control and Restraint (C&R) kit in the downstairs staff room. I was told during the briefing by Detainee Custody Manager (DCM) Steve Dix that DCO Paschali, DCO Dave Webb, DCO Alice Wragg and I would be ensuring was moved from his room on C wing to E wing room 7. DCM that detainee D1914 Dix informed us of the detainees medical and criminal history during the brief. I was allocated as the shield officer, Paschall as an arm officer, Webb as and arm officer and Wragg as the handcuff officer. Following the briefing we made our way to the room of Mr D1914 Steve Dix opened the detainees room door and I immediately entered with the aforementioned team as per my instructions. D1914 was sat on his bed and did not pose a risk to himself or the team. As a result I did not use the shield and engage the team in a restraint. D1914 quickly held his chest and appeared limp, falling to his side. DCO Paschali and DCO Webb put the detainee in the recovery position. Healthcare then assessed him and deemed him fit to be moved to E wing. DCM Steve Dix gave the detainee numerous opportunities to walk compliantly to the room on E wing. He did not take these opportunities so DCO Webb and DCO Paschali tried to assist him. The detainee resisted and became none compliant so we engaged in a restraint. I took control of the detainees head while DCO Webb and DCO Paschali took control of the detainees arms. Once the detainees hands were securely behind his back DCO Alice Wragg applied handcuffs to him. At this point I was able to release control of the detainees head. I only supported the detainees head when it was absolutely necessary, and when it was necessary I used the minimal amount of force required. In handcuffs the detainee began to comply. He was walked to E wing room 7. He entered compliantly. He then underwent a full search. I was instructed to leave the room before the full search took place. This concludes my report.

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
