VB: Is it the one about **D119**

MB: Yes it is. How or why do you think it is being investigated?

VB: D119 told me he put a complaint in and that you were looking into it. I told him that I cannot talk about it.

MB: Can you explain to me in your own words what you heard / saw?

VM: Yes, I was locking down the bottom floor, all the detainees were locked away. I could hear shouting coming from the next level.

MB: Who was shouting?

VM: It was D119 and Babs. As my roll count was done, because of the volume, I went up to the next level to help. Babs and D119 were arguing.

MB: What did you hear?

VM: They were shouting at each other, calling each other "dickheads"

MB; So **D119** called Babs a "dickhead?"

VM: Yes.

MB: And what did Babs say?

VM: He called D119 a "fucking dickhead". He said it a lot.

MB: Did D119 say?

VM: Babs said that he would take him to block and D119 said that he could try – they were really angry with each other. We were all trying to talk to D119 but he was shouting at Babs – myself and others told Babs to leave it but he was fixated on arguing with D119

MB: What happened next?
VM: I could hear banging <u>coming from anot</u> her room – I didn't want the whole wing to start banging so I went over to room to calm him down.
MB: Why was he upset?
VM: He could hear the arguing. He was saying that Babs was being unprofessional. He was really unhappy the situation. I talked to him for a bit and managed to calm him down. He said he was going to complain about it.
MB: What else did you hear?
VM: When Babs said about the block, D119 said that he would fight him without anyone else around (References the point in the CCTV footage where D119 stands up)
MB: Did you hear any other swearing?
VM: Babs was saying get in your fucking room or something like that.
MB: What did D119 say?
VM: He was really annoyed.
MB: Aggressive?
VM: I would say more annoyed.
MB: Was Babs aggressive?
VM: Yes – I was shouting at him and swearing at him.
MB: Did you hear D119 call Babs any names?
VM: No, I know he was swearing but not name calling.
MB: Did you hear the words "fucking coconut?"
VM: No
MB: How did Babs appear?
VM: It was a bit unprofessional – I have never had an issue with D119 – maybe it was because he didn't know him – we wanted to go home – we all know what D119 is like but Babs wasn't helping the situation.
MB: You are fairly new Vicky, what is your relationship like with D119?
VB: I have a good rapport with D119 - I worked nights on the wing not long ago - he is a cleaner so was out cleaning with no issues. It is how you speak to them.

MB: Did you perceive it that the situation could've escalated?

VM: In what way? MB; It was been reported that Babs was waving at D119 as he went into his room. VM: Yes – he was saying "Bye bye" – he said it a couple of times. It was patronising. You can see on the footage when Babs says it and D119 turns around. We put a barrier there to keep them apart. MB: Did you hear anything about wanting to go home? VB: Babs said something like "get in your room so I can go home and see my kids. MB: Did you hear D119 say something about Babs son? VB: No MB: Anything else you can think of? VB: No thank you. MB: Ok thanks Vick, please do not discuss this with anyone else, in the event that you do, it could compromise the investigation which could result in a disciplinary in its own right. VB: Of course MB; You will receive a copy of the minutes, any amendments that you wish to make and be added to the margin and reverse. Please check and sign them and return back to me. VM: Ok MB: Thanks Vicky. VM: Thank you.
