Sandra,

Thank you for organising the training of Healthcare staff in Gatwick. Please see the attached training slides, as promised.

We hope that the session on Thursday was useful for those who attended. It certainly raised some interesting points with us that we had not previously considered, nor had been raised when training Home Office staff. Consequently, we absolutely see the benefit of engaging with healthcare staff when considering future changes to the Detention Centre Rules (more specifically, the Rule 35 process) and will be in touch with yourself to organise consultation when we reach that stage.

I think that both Ian and I are on board with the idea of holding a case study session, whereby we retrospectively look at Rule 35 reports to clarify on ideas of whether a Rule 35 report should be raised/the account from the individual meets the definition of torture. Again, if you are content with being a point of contact, we will come through you to organise such a session.
