Mr D1914 presented to hospital with chest pain and palpitations. He reports feeling unwell for the last 2 weeks. He reports an associated cough productive of yellow sputum. He reports drinking alcohol the night before this, in celebration of his nieces birthday and waking at 4.30 this morning and smoking a cigarette following which he experienced a sudden onset of palpitations and chest pain. The pain radiated down both arms, the patient reported associated nausea and sweats and felt as though he was "going to die". He was tachycardic with a HR of 160 on admission. His ECG showed atrial flutter with 2:1 block. He was given Sensitive/Irrelevant he reverted to sinus rhythm 10 mins following this and reported feeling much better. Chest radiograph showed no obvious consolidation. Initial troponin was 45.4, and his repeat troponin was 503.6. Mr D1914 was given Sensitive/Irrelevant and Sensitive/Irrelevant as stat doses. No further treatment was given as Mr D1914 was very keen to leave hospital and self discharge, against the strong advice of medical staff. As a result we have arranged for him to have an OP angiogram and R test. He has been started on Sensitive/Irrelevant Sensitive/Irrelevant Sensitive/Irrelevant Sensitive/Irrelevant. He has been advised to return to hospital should he experience any further symptoms.

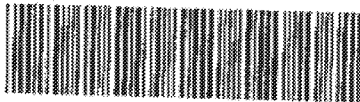

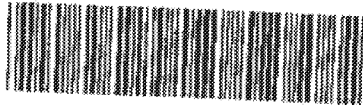
