Main Medicine management: Mr D1914 presented to CSRU having developed severe central chest pain at 10-10:30pm after having his evening meal, the pain radiated to the jaw and was associated with sweating. Severity was 10/10. There was no SOB or vomiting. The pain was improved by [ ] given by the paramedics. He has been experiencing dull aching chest pain daily over the past few months, usually once daily with or without exertion. On arrival his chest pain had resolved completely. His physical examination was unremarkable. The paramedics ECG demonstrated ST depression in V3-V5 and I, III, aVF. These changes had resolved on arrival. His troponin was 17.3, other bloods were unremarkable. Mr D1914 was advised to remain in hospital		

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for an inpatient admission with the view to contact Mr Bahrami to expedite his CABG. He however was determined to leave against medical advice – he was deemed to have capacity and understood that discharge against medical advice in this manner puts him at risk of further MI or even death. He has signed appropriate documentation and has been advised to seek medical attention urgently if he does develop further chest pain or feels unwell.

We will inform MR Bahrami of this further presentation with chest pain and request review for CABG at the earliest available date.

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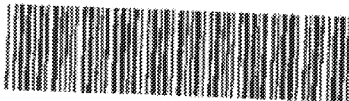

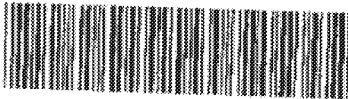
