Dear Mr Murphy,

Re: PSU investigation regarding a complaint made by Mr [D2953]

We spoke today regarding the ongoing investigation. In terms of the evidence I advised you there are no formal reports relating to any of the incidents however, there is evidence to indicate Mr [D2953] made a number of calls to the G4S Equalities Advisory Support Helpline and, during those calls mentioned he had been assaulted on three occasions. In addition a medical note also records Mr [D2953] had some 'old' injuries pre 29 June 2017.

With regards to the complaint you provided me with a verbal recollection which I have set out below. As agreed, grateful if you could please review the statement, if there are any inaccuracies please contact me as soon as is possible otherwise; please retain the letter for your records.

In response to the allegations you stated:

'You have nothing to answer for. You don't make a habit of assaulting detainees. You remember Mr [D2953] and did your best to reintegrate him on the wings but, every time you did this he would get into a fight with his roommate and would then end up back on E Wing. He used to bang a lot. He broke a couple of cups/crockery which can be sharp; these were the only times you had dealings with him. You can't understand the allegations. The allegations could possibly be because sometimes you had to say 'no' to Mr [D2953] You deny assaulting Mr [D2953] at anytime and wanted to make that clear.

Mr [D2953] used to walk around the wing saying it was his human rights and that he wanted compensation; he would do this every day and would annoy other detainees. He used to walk around in his boxer shorts which is not a nice sight particularly with female Officers around. If they asked Mr [D2953] to go into his room he kept saying it is his

human rights. You arranged for Mr [D2953] to be transferred to a the single occupancy Centre at the Verne but he ended up returning to Brook House.'

Finally my thanks to you for your ongoing assistance in the matter.
