Clinician Comments: This gentleman has a BG of double bypass (nov 2016) awaiting further elective CABG on August 7th, history of self harm. Under detention for immigration issues. He was referred to attend ED after D-dimer at health centre was raised, this was repeated and d-dimer is 577. Clinically leg does not look like DVT but given his raised D-dimer he was given clexane and DVT hotslot booked at 13:45, patient will be discharged back to detention centre and staff will bring him back for his appointment later today, time of scan 13:45 on 17.5.17. patient is to come to X ray department prior to above time and then to go to AMU chairs to wait for results of scan.
