The claimant is an ex soldier and convict. The claimant is detained.

Judicial Review Challenges

The claimant was an ex soldier who claims to have served in Kosovo wars and is a national of St Vincent and Grenades. The claimant is challenging the deportation order. The claimant is an ex convict Sensitive/Irrelevant The claimant states that deportation would be in breach of his Art 2 and 3 rights. The claimant states that he suffers from PTSD and mental health illness due to his service in as a soldier. The claimant claims that he is need of rehabilitation and that if deported that he would not be able to get this in St Vincent. He also states that he is in genuine and subsisting relationship with his daughter. The claimant states that he submitted about 3 PAPs which was not response to.

Instructions (on each separate challenge as appropriate)

I consider this case to be defensible and suitable for expedition. The claimant's Art 3 bad 8 were comprehensively considered and certified under the relevant rules in the decision letters 15 June 2016 and 20 March 2017. The claimant's criminal offence is a factor in the consideration to deport the claimant.
