# Gatwick IRC Use of Force report

### Overview



- Charter flights continue to be going well and the main focus of business
- A total of 212 admissions arrived in the month of November
- In November a total of 5 charter flights left from Brook House
- A total number of 23 detainees left on these flights
- Brook House had an average roll count of 122
- The highest 3 nationalities in November were Iran[58]/Sudan [55]/Iraq [44]
- The level of self-harm in November remained high this resulted in force being used on 14 occasions out of 26
- There were 4 Serious incidents Three times for Protect yourself and once to Prevent Escape in November which resulted in force being used 4 times





In the month of November 2020 force was used 26 times at Brook House IRC

The reasons for why force was used can be seen below

Maintain good order - 3

Prevent self-harm - 14

Prevent assault - 1

Protect yourself - 3

Prevent damage to centre property - 0

Prevent escape - 1

To facilitate removal directions: 4

Over the month of November six Planned Interventions resulted in no force and is broken down as follows.

Presented to Mitie - 5

Brought down to Care and Separation unit - 1

Over the month of November, a total of 13 teams were presented for a Planned Intervention's.

Seven times Force was used with the other six being compliant making a comparison of 54% for Forced used to the 46% No Force used





### Monthly Planned UOF Comparator




### **UOF Mitigation Breakdown**






### Brook House -Personal Protection / Spontaneous / Planned 2020






### Brook House – Locations for force being used in November 2020






### Brook House – Locations for force being used






# Brook House – Number of times force was used to prevent self-harm








### Brook House – Nationality Breakdown





Our highest population was 58 residents from Iran with force being used 9 times on this nationality

We had 55 residents from Sudan with a total amount of 2 times force was used.

Out of the 44 Residents from Iraq force was used 11 times on this nationality

Out of the 26 Use Of Force incidents a total of 22 was from our top 3 Nationalities

### Tinsley House



In the month of November Tinsley House was used as a shortterm holding facility

They had a total of 162 detainees arrived during the month of November

They had No Use Of Force incidents over November

### Gatwick IRC – Injuries due to Use Of Force



In the month of November there were a total of 0 New injuries to staff across Gatwick IRC

DCO injury carried on From October 20th from a Spontaneous incident but returned on the 30th of November on a phased return due to an injury to left knee

- O happened during spontaneous incidents
- O happened during planned incidents

Over the Year to date we have had 11 injuries due to Use Of Force.

# Gatwick IRC – PSU Investigations / Training



Currently there are the following PSU Investigations we may not know the outcome of this, but this does not show under out Mitigation notes anymore. I will continue to document this as outstanding until further instruction Refresher dates in December are: 07/12/2020 14/12/2020 Advanced Refresher Dates are being sorted by we sorting this for 2021. We have also put out a notice to staff to apply for Advanced control and restraint training with the closing date being the 18/12/2020. We have

already had a good number of staff apply.
