



D1467 stated that he was filming with DCO Callum Tulley for about 3 months in Brook House and had captured the following incidents:

- A detainee whose flight was cancelled attempted suicide and cut his wrists and staff are seen ignoring him.
- An officer telling an Indian detainee “don’t give a fuck”, and “fuck off.”
- People filmed ‘slamming-flaps’ and taking drugs.
- A detainee having a spice-attack, a nurse attended stating ‘I don’t care’ and laughing along with other staff.
- DCO Luke Instone-Brewer on Delta-exercise yard accepting £4000 to bring drugs into the centre, giving him a bank account number, to which £4000 was paid into.
- DCO Instone-Brewer coming into his room a few days later, banged the wall, tapped the window and threw a package onto his bed containing drugs and left.

D1467 stated that the BBC paid the £4000 into the bank account and this was done to prove how easy it was to get drugs into the centre.

D1467 stated that he took possession of the drugs from DCO Instone-Brewer and kept them hidden for approximately 8 weeks.

D1467 stated that the package was the size of an A5 envelope.

D1467 stated he was aware that DCO Instone-Brewer had resigned a month ago as “it had come on top and he got scared.”

D1467 stated that he bought an Iphone5s mobile phone from within Brook House and started to record incidents himself. He stated he was emailing the BBC and filming live as well as bits for Callum Tulley.

D1467 stated he handed out the drugs, camera equipment and the iPhone containing all the footage to his solicitor and a Home Office Interpreter on a visit at Brook House on 7th September 2017.
