Sian: Yeah.

Callum Tulley: What did he say to you?

Sian [surname unknown]: Emm, this wasn't that bad actually. Not as bad as the girl who - whose - you know there was a girl in the dinner queue and he [inaudible].

Callum Tulley: Did he?

Sian [surname unknown]: Yeah, he was [inaudible] about bombing people and like, 'It's gonna be worse than the Manchester bombings,' and all this shit. [Inaudible] just told me that if anyone [inaudible] me, he was gonna move it for me and he was gonna do something about it. And I was just like, '[inaudible]'. And I was racist, because he's brown.

Callum Tulley: [Laughs] He's not brown, he's not. He's white.

Sian [surname unknown]: He is white, however, I wasn't going to sit there and have an argument with him about whether he's white. [Inaudible].

D544 [Inaudible].

Callum Tulley: You need to - No, basically [inaudible] is the short answer, but I don't know how to -

D244 [Tuts and makes a frustrated face, banging his head with his fist.]

D544 It's these documents here. Read and see what it say [inaudible], because he cannot read.

Speaker: But he cannot understand English, **D544**, so it doesn't make a difference mate.

D544 [Inaudible] to translate, to tell him. You know what I mean? Because I don't know - I don't know, em, that he's [inaudible].

D244 [Stares across the room, expressionless.]

Callum Tulley: [Speaking to **D244**] It says you will not be removed before the 5th of June 2017 at 5 hours. After this time and for 3 months from this date of this notice, you may be removed without further notice.

D244 [Continues to look expressionless.]

D544: Okay, it says [inaudible].

Callum Tulley: So -

D544: We haven't got no [inaudible]. I don't know what to do man. [Inaudible].

Callum Tulley: [Hands documents to **D544**] This is impossible, mate, he needs to - I don't really know what to say - he needs to go to welfare, really.

D544: Yeah, but he don't know what to do [inaudible]. Somebody have to take him. I can't do all this work here man.

Callum Tulley: Nah, I know man.

D544 Someone [inaudible]

Callum Tulley: The problem is, **D544** neither can we mate. To be honest with you.

D544: Sorry?

Callum Tulley: Neither can we. There's over 100 detainees in this wing and there's 2 officers working on the wing.

D544 But he definitely need help, man.

Callum Tulley: Yeah, I know, I know, I know.

D544: So, you know, someone [inaudible] have to go take him man. And [inaudible]. And [inaudible] don't know nothing [inaudible]. [Walks out door.]

Callum Tulley: Yeah, I know. Alright, cheers. Cheers.

Male detainee 1: [Enters room] [Inaudible] go and get some papers please?

Callum Tulley: No, I'm in the middle of something, mate. [Speaking to Ed] Ed, Ed. What do I do with this guy? [Inaudible]. [Speaking to **D244**] You basically mate - you don't have no money. No money.

D244 [Inaudible] [shakes his head and his hand and is visibly frustrated.]

Callum Tulley: But I don't speak Chinese, that's the problem.

D244 [Inaudible]

Callum Tulley: No - me no Chinese. But this - this card, yeah? [Shows him a card.] No cigarette. No cigarette, because no money. No smoke, no money. [Hands card to **D244**]

D244 No money means no smoke.

D244 [Looks very frustrated.]

[Callum walks through door with **D244**]

Male officer 1: You okay there?

Callum Tulley: I'm fine.

Male officer 1: Okay.

Callum Tulley: I don't know how I've ended up - I don't know how I've been pulled into this.

Male officer 1: [Inaudible] to go? [Inaudible].

Callum Tulley: Nah, nah, nah. I'm doing [inaudible] one. But this guy (**D544**) has asked me to try and look after this guy and find out what's wrong with him. Should I just leave it?

Male officer 1: Well, he doesn't speak English, so how are you going to find out? Unless another China guy.

Callum Tulley: Yeah, that's what I've been trying to do, but I can't - there's not really anything I can do. Is there?

Male officer 1: There's 83 of them.

Callum Tulley: [Speaking to **D244**] Hot. It hurts?

Ed Fiddy: [Speaking to **D244**] Is it hurting?

D244: [Nods and screws up face in pain, grabbing his foot.]

Ed Fiddy: [Speaking to **D244**] Pain? Bad?

Female officer 1: Maybe take him to [inaudible] -

Ed Fiddy: What's the word for pain in Chinese?

Callum Tulley: I don't know, how would I know that?

Ed Fiddy: Why don't you know that?

Callum Tulley: [Laughs]

Ed Fiddy: Do you not work in this multicultural w- [laughs]?

Male staff member 1: Just take him up to healthcare. Take him up to healthcare [inaudible].

Ed Fiddy: Yeah. [Taps Male detainee 1 on shoulder.]

Male staff member 1: [Inaudible]

Ed Fiddy: [Speaking to D244] [Inaudible] [Taps D244 on shoulder and signals with his hand for him to stand up.] Come.

Female officer 1: Yeah, I carry it around with me.
