942 and he went, 'Oh look. [Inaudible] has marked my arm.' And he has got a mark.

944 **Female Officer 1:** Like somebody has – [mimics someone grabbing top of her arm].
945 **Male Officer 1:** At the end of the day, Graham you know, you know better. You
946 should know better than not to grab someone in a place like this.
947 **Callum Tulley:** What you mean? Yeah. Yeah. You shouldn't. Yeah.
948 **Male Officer 1:** You don't go around grabbing people. Not when everyone is on about
949 you've got to cover your ass all the time. You can't start going grabbing people up.
950 **Callum Tulley:** Yeah. It's true. Do you reckon he'll get disciplined for that?
951 **Male Officer 1:** Yeah, he'll get in trouble for that, especially if he puts in a report.
952 Because they'll watch the CCTV of it. I know on CCTV you can't hear anything, so what it
953 will look like is he walked past and Graham just grabbed him. So it'll look [inaudible].
954 **Female Officer 1:** He knows how to play it.
955 **Callum Tulley:** Graham.
956 **Female Officer 1:** He knows how to play it, these guys are [inaudible].
957 **Callum Tulley:** It's a new Graham, isn't it?
958 **Male Officer 1:** Yeah, he's fairly new. He's normally on B wing.
959 **Callum Tulley:** Black hair? Black hair?
960 **Male Officer 1:** Yeah. Yeah. He's got black hair, yeah.
961 **Female Officer 1:** These guys are not stupid though, they know.
962 **Callum Tulley:** Yeah [inaudible] right.
963 **Female Officer 1:** Yeah, he's alright.
964 **Callum Tulley:** But he shouldn't – that detainee well he shouldn't – like he wasn't –
965 that's not his wing is it?
966 **Female Officer 1:** No. Apparently he went on the wing yesterday that he was on, to use
967 a fax machine, and he was really arsey with him then. And then today, he went to go on
968 A wing, and I think he was winding him up more than anything. Because he said he went
969 in there to look for someone, and then Graham practically wrapped him up to get him
970 out. Tried to wrap his arm up to get him out.
971 **Male Officer 1:** [Inaudible] has been suspended for talking to a detainee badly. So if
972 he's on camera grabbing one, trying to wrestle him off the wing.
973 **Female Officer 1:** Well I felt bad because –
974 **Male Officer 1:** He's on probation.
975 **Female Officer 1:** Because I felt bad, because it was like [inaudible].
976 **Callum Tulley:** Silly sausage.
977 **Female Officer 1:** And I went around because he was raising his voice and all that.
978 Then I walked back down and he said about the mark. So I had to then go over – I went
979 and spoke to [inaudible] because I couldn't find Dean, and I said, 'Look, Dean knows
980 about it.' I said I just wanted to stay out of it. I said, but at the end of the day he told
