DCM Lyden and myself spoke to **D1527** upon reception into Brook House as he arrived on an open ACDTY from HMP Belmarsh. I explained to **D1527** the ACDT process and he fully understood about the care plan. I asked how he was and he said ok. I confirmed his that his transfer was from Belmarsh and if he had a RD's served or not. He stated that he was on remand in Belmarsh and all charges were dropped. I explained the regime of Brook and that it was not like prison. He seemed happier that he was here rather than prison. He did say that he has a solicitor working for him and he wished to speak to him. I explained that he would be given a phone for him to use and we could facilitate a phone call if needed. I asked if he currently had any thoughts to hurt himself and **D1527** immediately replied no he hadn't. I explained that he would be in a room on his own tonight and that he may be asked in future to share and he said no problem. Although softly spoken he displayed good body language and was cooperative throughout the review. It was decided to place on observations of one every 3 hours for an initial period with a further review to take place tomorrow.

Summary of review (if ACDT plan is closed, state why)

D1527 subdued at interview, eye contact poor. Answered questions fully however, and fully engaged in the review.

I started by asking **D1527** what was happening with his immigration case. He confirmed he has a solicitor (Duncan Lewis), but he was rather vague on what they were doing. I had been informed by R Gibson in the Home Office that he has retained Duncan Lewis, he intends to pursue a Rule 35 torture claim (as yet unsubmitted), that there are currently no RDs set, and that he has an interview today with regards obtaining an ETD. He has not yet seen a GP to pursue his Rule 35 claim, and I advised him he needs to do that himself, and also he needs to keep in contact with his solicitor. (he was 5.5 months in HMP on remand on charges which have now been dropped) – he agreed he would make an appointment with GP re Rule 35, and also liaise with his solicitor.

When asked if he has any thoughts of self harm , he stated no. he has no intention of killing himself or self harming in any other way. I advised him that officers were here to assist him, and he agreed he would talk to officers if he felt stressed. RMN J Newlands had no info on D1527 but confirmed he has an RMN appointment on 12.04.17.

All present agreed to leave obs level unchanged, and a further review was set for 07.04.17

Summary of review (if ACDT plan is closed, state why)

Prior to the case review Mr D1527 was found in C-Wing courtyard laughing and joking with friends as soon as Mr D1527 was approached about attending his case review his mood and demeanour changed.

Case review carried out in the B-Wing Office Mr D1527 was at first reluctant to engage but this changed as the review went on and he was happy to answer questions put to him. I asked Mr D1527 how he was to which he replied that he was not good, Mr D1527 said that he needed medication for his neck and that he hasn't had his antidepressant medication lately. Nurse K.Churcher informed Mr D1527 that his antibiotics for his neck would arrive tomorrow as the doctor had only completed the prescription today and that his antidepressants were now in stock and that he needed to collect these at lunchtime each day, Mr D1527 acknowledged this with a nod. Mr D1527 said that he was sometimes struggling with anxiety attacks due to his current situation, K.Churcher reminded Mr D1527 that he has an RMN appointment on the 12th and that they will be able to assist him with coping mechanisms for this. Mr D1527 is in regular contact with friends but said he has no family in the UK so is not expecting any visitors. I asked Mr D1527 about his Immigration case to which he said that he had seen the Home Office today and they had informed him that they are looking to arrange travel documents for him at this time, Mr D1527 does not want to return to his own country but is aware they are no removal directions in place at present, Mr D1527 does currently have a solicitor in place who is working on his case. I asked Mr D1527 if he has any thoughts of self-harm at present. Mr D1527 said that he has the occasional thought but that he would be happy to approach staff if he felt that he may do something to act on these thoughts.

Mr **D1527** was asked by DCO **A.Ajgaybee** to attend B-Wing office for his case review, Mr **D1527** refused this request so I made my way up to the 2nd floor of B-Wing where I saw Mr **D1527** laughing and joking playing pool with other detainees, on my approach to Mr **D1527** his demeanour and facial expressions changed to indicate a low mood.

I asked Mr **D1527** if he was willing to attend his case review after he had finished his game of pool to which he said no and that he was not willing to speak with me, I asked Mr **D1527** if there was a time later in the day that would suit him better and also if he preferred to speak with someone else, he replied by saying that he was not willing to attend any review at any time with anyone and no longer wished to speak with me further, he then turned his back and started another game of pool. Mr **D1527** was reminded to attend healthcare this afternoon as his antibiotics were due to be delivered, he just stared at DCO **A.Ajgaybee** and gave no verbal response quickly returning to his game of pool once again.

Healthcare were contacted prior to the review as they were unable to attend and have no immediate concerns, they just re-iterated that he has an RMN appointment on the 12th which Mr **D1527** is already aware of and that his antibiotics were due for delivery this afternoon.

I spoke with DCO **K.Mankellow** following Mr **D1527**'s refusal to attend his review to gauge Mr **D1527**'s mood and demeanour that morning, DCO **K.Mankellow** said that he appeared to be in good spirits and when asked if he was ok he stated that he was.

D1527 was hard to engage with as he showed a very immature attitude, he had made very superficial scratches to his left wrist, We asked him his issues he said was ok and would not do it again. Isaid that we are here to help him and have welfare officers who are trained to help all detainees. He was asked by june if he had any thoughts of hurting himself he said he did not. **D1527** said he made the scratches with his fingers but I suspect it was his phone card. I asked him again if he wanted to harm his self he said he did not and would not try it again. While having a discussion after the review I left DCO Minter with him. As **D1527** is on an open ACDT and his Observations are every 3 hours and with advice from healthcare it was decided to increase his observation to hourly until his next review which with healthcare advice should be AM 08/04/2017.

At about 16:05 he went to the wing office and asked for his medication, when the officers could not get through to healthcare first time he walked out of the office and throw a chair down the wing in frustration then returned to his room and cut his arm with a razor blade, he then returned to the office and asked for a plaster, he was taken to healthcare and spoken to by DCM A Lyden, DCM H Attwater and myself DCM S Webb. After we spoke to D1527 he reassured that he would not hurt himself anymore and would talk to officers if he thought he would do it again, D1527 stated he has had some bad news that the Home Office are putting a travel document together to send D1527 back to Egypt. D1527 was advised to contact his solicitor and see healthcare tomorrow, D1527 agreed to do this. D1527's observations have now changed to 1 observation every hour, to be reviewed on the 10/04/2017

Emergency case review carried out with **D1527** after an RMN appointment with Karen Churcher where **D1527** stated that he had nothing to live for and would tie a bed sheet around his neck, he then proceeded to kick a chair and leave the talking therapies room. I was immediately asked to go to B wing to see **D1527**. DCO Waldock went to get **D1527** from his room and he reluctantly attended the review which took place in the Res DCM's office. I asked **D1527** what had just happened. **D1527** did not speak and displayed poor body language and eye contact, by just looking at the floor. I asked about what had just happened with the RMN but he just replied I'm ok. I asked if he had any thoughts to hurt himself and he said he didn't. I explained to **D1527** of our duty of care and safety towards him and I had to be sure that he would not try to hurt or kill himself and he said he wouldn't. I asked if anything had happened to make him feel like this as he had had an earlier review with DCM H Attwater where he seemed in good spirits and his observations were able to be reduced. **D1527** didn't really want to answer any questions due to his low mood, except to say that he was upset that his friends were unable to arrange a visit because there was no one answering the visits telephone line. I took it upon myself to phone the switchboard and ask the staff to expect a telephone call regarding the visit. Alex on the switchboard was kind enough to take the details of the intended visitor and would ring to book him in. Once completed the staff would then ring B wing to confirm the visit. **D1527** seemed happy by this. I asked if there was anything else and he said no thank you. I asked him again about his feelings to hurt himself and he gave me his word he wouldn't do anything and would call an officer if he needed help. In light of his statements to the RMN and his seemingly low mood that his observations be increased to ONE OBSERVATION WITHIN EVERY HOUR ALONG WITH ONE CONVERSTAIION PER DAY. Also the date of his next review to be bought forward from the 14th April to tomorrow the 13th April.

Mr D1527 told me that he had seen his solicitor yesterday and felt positive that they will be taking on his case. Mr D1527 is attending healthcare regularly for his medication and has a rule 35 appointment with the doctor scheduled at 1515 today he also has his RMN appointment at 1530 which he said he was looking forward to. At present Mr D1527 does not have any thoughts of self harm and is eating, drinking and sleeping well, he is also participating in centre activities and is proactive with his time. Mr D1527 displayed good body language and eye contact throughout the review and maintains that he will speak with staff if anything changes within his circumstances.

Prior to the review I spoke with the Home Office who said there is no flight set at present and they are waiting for Mr D1527's solicitor to submit a new Asylum claim as mentioned previously by Mr D1527

Today we met with D1527 who spoke openly about his situation, he stated he was feeling better and he had no thoughts of self harm or suicide he has a solicitor working on his case and he wants to try and get released or to go for Bail.

He is also happy because he R35 have been submitted and agreed by healthcare and this has been passed onto the relevant people. D1527 stated he is on medication and he does not feel this is working but I have told him to let it settle into his system and give it a chance to work and he said he would do, but he knows to speak to healthcare if he continues to feel it is not working. Information from RMN is that he needs to take it regularly and daily as he is quite hit and miss with it.

D1527 states sometimes he feels quite stressed and frustrated and this makes him feel and think bad thoughts of self harm but he is finding ways to deal with this which was reassuring to hear. D1527 stated when he feels like this he may tell us which was reassuring to hear.

As he states he has no thoughts of self harm or suicide the panel decides to lower his observations 1x every 3 hours and 1 conversation a day

We asked but there was nothing else we could help him with but he said thank you and we told him to call his bell throughout the night if he wanted to speak with us and we would come and see him. Again he said thank you and we left him to try and sleep.

No raised concerns for the detainee and obs changed to 1 every 2 hours and review to be conducted again tomorrow as planned.

Case review carried out in the B-Wing office, although Mr D1527 attended the office for the review he was not really willing to engage, he displayed very little eye contact and appeared to be very low in mood.

I asked Mr D1527 how he was but he just mumbled fine, I asked if he had any thoughts of self-harm at present to which he replied that he didn't know, I tried to get Mr D1527 to explain further but he would not elaborate further. Mr D1527 agreed that he had submitted a rule 35 and that he does have a solicitor in place at present he also said that he speaks to friends on his phone but gave minimal information to anything I asked him and sometimes I could not understand him due to his mumbling. I asked Mr D1527 whether he had eaten yesterday to which he said no as he had no appetite I asked if he planned to try again today but again he said no. Despite numerous efforts by all those involved within the review Mr D1527 was not interested in discussing any issues he may have at present.

Due to his lack of engagement and low mood his level of care has been increased to hourly observations and another review has been set for tomorrow.

Following the review RMN D.Dowd called me to confirm medication and appointment times for Mr D1527 I then reminded Mr D1527 that he should collect his medication at 1330 hours today, he has a Doctor's appointment at 1500 today and that he is due to see the RMN on Thursday the 20th at 1430 hours, Mr D1527 acknowledged the information I gave him and thanked me.

After numerous attempts to complete a review between the times stated above, **D1527** refused to engage with either myself or the wing officers. **D1527** refused to even make eye contact with us when attempting to converse with him. Due to this I was unable to complete a full case review. Anika from the Home Office has stated that **D1527** has put in a Rule 35 application and that it has been received today. RMN James Newland states that he has attempted to make observations on **D1527**, however he is also unwilling to communicate with him or take his observations. **D1527** is now also deemed as a food/fluid refusal as he has now gone 48 hours without taking a centre issue meal. **D1527** has not bought anything from the shop today, however he did buy four (4) energy drinks, one (1) nourishment drink, four (4) Mr Tom peanut bars, one (1) snickers bar, one (1) bag of doritos crisps and one(1) tin of mackerel fish yesterday. According to the wing officers, **D1527** will only communicate with his case manager DCM Hayley Attwater and so I have scheduled his next case review for 21/04/2017 when DCM Hayley Attwater is next in.

Case review carried out in the C-Wing office, although Mr D1527 attended the office for the review and initially appeared to be in good spirits once again he displayed very little eye contact and appeared to become low in mood as the review went on.

Mr D1527 was not very engaging and mumbled basic answers to questions not wanting to elaborate, I asked Mr D1527 if he had been in contact with his friends recently to which he said yes usually every few days, he told me that he had had a visit from his social worker yesterday and hoped that they would visit again soon but did not know when this would be. I asked Mr D1527 if he was eating better now to which he said he was, I asked whether he was now attending for his medication daily but once again he said that he forgets sometimes not taking it regularly, I re-iterated the importance of taking this regularly and as before he agreed that he would. Mr D1527 told me that he has spoken to his solicitor recently who had no updates for him and said they would contact him in due course with information. Mr D1527 told me that he is happy on C-Wing and with his current roommates. I asked Mr D1527 whether he has any thoughts of self-harm at present to which he eventually said yes then through further perseverance he claims to have these thoughts 10-15 times a day, Mr D1527 would give no assurances with regards to self-harm and said that he may or may not tell staff, he wouldn't elaborate on any plans on when he has these thoughts but did mention that he was unable to see the RMN yesterday due to the appointment clashing with his visit, he was keen to arrange another appointment as soon as possible which I felt was a positive sign.

Following the review I contacted the RMN and have arranged a new RMN appointment for today at 1630. Level of care to remain at hourly observations due to thoughts of self-harm and low mood.

Emergency case review carried out in Mr. D1527's room as he refused to attend the C-Wing office, I received information from RMN K.Churcher that Mr. D1527 had mentioned that he may kill himself by hanging himself, he refused to elaborate further on this statement.

On arrival on C-Wing I was approached by staff who said that they had called healthcare to see Mr. D1527 as he appeared to be unwell when they had locked him up for roll count. I entered D1527's room where I found him lying on the top bunk of his bed with his arms covering his face, I asked Mr. D1527 if he was ok to which he replied yes just leave me alone, I asked Mr. D1527 to look at me as I wanted to check his wellbeing and ensure that he had not cut himself as he had previously. Mr. D1527 refused to move but promised that he had not self-harmed I asked whether he was intending to again he replied no. Mr. D1527 said there was nothing wrong with him but continued to ask us to leave him alone, I told Mr. D1527 that healthcare would be attending to check him as the wing staff were concerned that he was unwell, he said that he didn't want to see or speak to anyone. On arrival of healthcare they tried to speak with him but he refused to allow them to check him, I asked Mr. D1527 why he had said to K.Churcher that he may kill himself he replied by saying I don't know, I asked if he intends to kill himself but he said no I just want to be left alone. I asked Mr. D1527 if he was going to eat dinner to which he said no, I then asked if he would eat tomorrow to which he said no again, when I asked about the days after this he said maybe he will see. Throughout the review Mr. D1527 kept his face covered and mumbled answers to the questions I asked, prior to leaving the room I checked Mr. D1527 and could see no visible signs of self-harm. Following the review I contacted K.Churcher and agreed that we would case review Mr. D1527 again first thing tomorrow morning at 0930 she also told me that he has another RMN appointment scheduled at 1830 tomorrow evening which at the time of his afternoon appointment he agreed that he would attend.
