
On 21 april 2017 around 13.50pm I DCO Gus Olyaie was on my lunch break at brook house staff room ground floor when first response call regarding a incident in A wing and E wing corridor was called.

I along side 2 other officers rushed out of staff room and towards the incident .as we arrived dco kye clark was locking the corridor door in order to contain detainee **D2636** . We opened the door and officer ryan Bromley asked him to put the pool queue down which he did I also had dco jack lainchbury and dco Demba Camara by my side. After the broken pool stick was removed from the scene I approached detainee **D2636** and asked him if he was ok and what is wrong to which he didn't respond I then asked him to get his hands out of his pockets as I felt he had something in his pocket that could harm him and us.he said no and very quickly after saying no took his right hand which was fisted and attacked DCO Jack lainchbury. At this point we dco camara me and dco lainchbury all went in to spontaneous C & R Dco lainchbury had the right arm Dco camara had the left arm detainee was on his back on the floor as we had to pull him to the floor as he was very aggressive I had to put my body weight on him as he was kicking to restrain his legs at this point dcm steve webb grabbed and restrain **D2636** legs and I moved on to grab and hold of the head for detainees safety . we then proceeded to seat **D2636** up we asked him to be clam I then was asked by dcm steve webb to let go of his head which I did . we walked mr **D2636** to e wing csu and I did a full search on **D2636** and put in to a room.





I Steve Webb Have been a DCO for 6 years and have been a DCM for 8 months. I have been working at Brook House for 8 months as a Residential Manager in charge of Arun and Eden wings. I was on the first floor corridor when over the radio a first response call was made and the area was corridor between Arun wing and Eden wing. When I arrived there were officers already in attendance, officers began to restrain the detainee and then the detainee took himself to the ground and started to move swing his legs around, in this incident the legs are a weapon and the detainee had already attacked 4 officers with a pool cue, I took hold of the legs and restrained them til the officers on the arms had gained control, I then moved myself away from the legs so the restraint was not excessive, the detainee then started to comply with the officers they were instructed to move to final lock position where the detainee became agitated and aggressive again. I once again i restrained the legs so they could not become a weapon, once he detainee was under control again, I extracted myself off of the legs so the detainee could be made to stand. He was then moved to the Care and Separation unit under final lock and given a full search was given, and placed onto Rule 40. he then was asked if he would walk into the room compliantly and walk to the back of the room, **D2636** did this compliantly and the door was closed. this end my report S Webb

I, DCO Jack Lainchbury have been working at Brook House IRC since January 2017. On 21/04/2017 at approximately 13:50 I was involved in an incident outside of A wing, I was a first responding officer.

At approximately 13:50 I was on my break sitting in the staff room. A first response was called over the radio and I made my way to the corridor outside A Wing. When myself, DCO Ryan Bromley and DCO Gus Olyaie arrived I saw DCO Kye Clark in the corridor and he had locked detainee D2636 in the sterile area outside A wing. I noticed the detainee was holding 2 halves of a pool cue. The detainee was asked to put the pool cue down, which he did. We then opened the door and removed the pool cues from the area.


The detainee was asked to remove his hands from his pockets in case he had anything else in his hands. The detainee was then asked what was wrong which was when he tried to punch me. I, DCO Olyaie and DCO Camara then restrained the detainee in order to maintain everyone's safety. I took hold of the detainee's right arm, the detainee continued to struggle so we guided him to the floor. Once on the floor I ensured I had control of his right arm before moving to a final lock. As a team we then sat the detainee up, following this we continued to a standing position. From the standing position we proceeded to escort the detainee to CSU.

After putting the pool cue down, D2636 was uncompliant throughout the whole incident.



I DCO (Detention Custody Officer) Kye Clarke was working on Arun Wing in Brook House IRC on Friday 21/04/2017 when at approximately 1345 I heard someone banging on the door of Arun Wing from the inside which they (detainees) commonly do to get the attention of staff to open the door. As I opened the door there was a detainee wearing black standing in front of me & the tip half of a snapped pool cue came through the air & struck the door just missing my face, I bent down to pick it up as I did D2636 came through the door & said “can I have that back?” I told him ‘no’ & he walked towards me, made a thrust for my lower abdomen with the snapped pool cue he had in his hand I stepped back towards the wall & putting my hands up defensively & avoided the thrust he then swung from the right & hit my left elbow I threw the other piece of the cue onto the floor & reached for my emergency button as I did he took a swing from the left which didn’t make contact, the door to Arun wing was opened by DCO Aminul HOQUE which took D2636’s attention away from me so I could move I shouted to DCO HOQUE to close the door he pulled the door to and once I was out of the corridor & locked the green door to association DCO HOQUE pushed his door open again & D2636 started walking towards him. D2636 raised his hand & threw a cue half at DCO HOQUE’s Leg then tried to gain entry back onto Arun wing. Once DCO HOQUE had closed the door D2636



D2636 walked towards my door. I had behind me DCO Ryan BROMLEY & DCO Jack LANCHBURY who attended the first response. I told them we aren't going in there while he has those weapons in his hands DCO Demba CAMARA opened the door to Eden wing as D2636 threw the cue pieces into the corner of my door. D2636 started to march towards DCO Demba CAMARA who had came out of Eden wing. I opened my door & went into the corridor followed by DCO's BROMLEY & LANCHBURY I removed the weapons from the area & joined the officers who attended I asked D2636 to remove his hands from his pockets so we can see his hands. D2636 then pushed & struck DCO LANCHBURY this initiated the Control & Restraint I went to grab an arm but was pushed aside & grabbed D2636 around the waist I heard an order shouted take him to the ground & I pulled down using my body weight to help bring him quickly & safely to the ground to get him under control. I noticed that his head wasn't secured & I held his head while he was supine position I was kneeled above his head keeping control. I had a large shooting pain go through my arm & I called for DCO Gus OLYALE to take control of his head, we switched over & I stepped back from the Control & Restraint. D2636 was escorted to the Care & Separation Unit. I was seen by healthcare & was sent to the hospital to get assessed.

I am a Detainee Custody Officer, Demba Camara worked in Brook House IRC for 10 months. At approximately 13:45 hours On the 21/04/2017 I attended a first response called at Brook House IRC between A and E wing.

I finished taking my break at approximately 13:40 hours as I got in to E wing, wing office I heard a radio called for first response, which mentioned that "the person has got a pool stick". As I approached E Wing door, I slightly opened the door and I saw [D2636] standing close to A- Wing door with both his hands in his pocket and two parts of the pool stick laying on the floor around the exit leading to A and E wing. I then opened E Wing door fully and stood around the door, at this point I deemed it unnecessary to use force. I asked [D2636] what was the problem, he stood innocently with his hands in his pocket, and responded 'am fine, no problem and you?'. I respond yes I'm ok.


Suddenly, DCO Kye Clarke, Jack Lainchbury and Gus Olyaie came through the corridor that leads to A and E wing doors, where the broken pool stick was. DCO Gus Olyaie moved the broken pool stick out of the way and he asked [D2636] to remove his hands off his pocket, at this point DCO Olyaie, Lainchbury, Clarke and myself were asking him to remove his hands from his pocket.

[D2636] refused to pull his hands out off his pocket as DCO Clarke and Lainsbury approached him, [D2636] came towards them with a blow, trying to hit DCO Clarke, Olyaie and Lainchbury. At this point I deemed it absolutely necessary to approach [D2636] from the back to get hold of his left hand. I grab the left hand and knelt down to the floor to get him down on the floor. We placed [D2636] on the floor. At this point I still had hold of the left arm straight before locking up the left hand. In locking the left hand I slide my hand through the back of his left hand and placed a final lock on [D2636] which I am trained for and still in ticket, This is approved by the Home Office for use of correct control and restraint techniques. I placed my thumb between [D2636]'s index and middle finger to gain control of [D2636] hand. [D2636] was still resistant throughout the control and restrain. However, [D2636] was asked to remain calm throughout control and restrain, as we did the lock on we assisted [D2636] up to a seated position, we then assisted [D2636] to a stand position and proceeded to walk him down to E Wing CSU room 003. He was searched under restraint and then taken to the door to CSU room 003 where all the lock were removed and we asked [D2636] to walk into his room and he complied and walked into CSU 003.

This conclude my report the use of force on [D2636] was reasonable in this circumstance and For the safety of my colleagues and myself, proportionate use of force was necessary in this circumstance.

I report no injuries at this present time but will report accordingly if one arises.


