Adaptibility is important too, as are patience, communication skills and a genuine commitment to helping people.		
in addition, you'll need a good level of basic fitness, which will be tested as part of the application process. While English doesn't need to be your first language - and in fact, additional languages are a nuge bonus - we'll also test your English and Meths skills (to Lovel 2 Key Skills).
