103 **D2509** : Yeah.  
104 **Dalliah Dowd**: I can't give you this stuff if you don't eat. And you know every morning, sorry.

107 **Dalliah Dowd**: Every morning – you can't eat that.

109 **Dalliah Dowd**: You can't eat that. That's stale. I come before and I asked him to eat. I can't  
110 give you the medication if you don't eat.  
111 **D2509** : [puts down the book to pick up an apple] I can't. This?  
112 **Dalliah Dowd**: Why you don't eat? Why you don't eat?  
113 **D2509** : I can't. I can't eating [lifts up his shirt].  
114 **Dalliah Dowd**: I told you to eat something before I come, isn't it?  
115 **D2509** : I can't eating, but eating apple and banana, and milk.  
116 **Dalliah Dowd**: What happened to tea and [inaudible]? You don't want tea this morning. What  
117 happened to bread? You don't want bread.  
118 **D2509** : [inaudible] [put down the apple and take a piece of bread from a bag on the  
119 table].  
120 **Dalliah Dowd**: You don't have butter. You don't have butter?

123 **D2509** : [Picks up a small packet] This butter?

148 **Callum Tulley**: In Iraq? Or maybe in the jungle in Calais in north of France?

150 **Callum Tulley**: No. In Iraq?

296 sternum], and [touches a point on his back].  
297 Callum Tulley: So [inaudible] should you be here?  
298 D2509 : Sorry.  
299 Callum Tulley: Take a seat. Take a seat man. Should you be here?  
300 D2509 : [inaudible] be here.  
301 Callum Tulley: Do you think you should be in Brook House?  
302 D2509 : What I?  
303 Callum Tulley: No. No. Why are you – why are you here?  
304 D2509 Ah! Uh...  
305 Callum Tulley: In detention.  
306 D2509 In immigration?  
307 Callum Tulley: Mm-hmm.  
308 D2509 Immigration [makes the crossed wrists gesture again].  
309 Callum Tulley: Why?  
310 D2509 : [shrugs] I don't know – I am no fighting, I am no everything.  
311 Callum Tulley: Are you a criminal?  
312 D2509 Sorry?  
313 Callum Tulley: Are you a criminal? Have you committed any crimes in this country, been to  
314 prison in the UK?  
315 D2509 I am not...  
316 Callum Tulley: You don't understand?  
317 D2509 No.  
318 Callum Tulley: Where is your book? Can you pass me over –  
319 D2509 : Yes, please.  
320 Callum Tulley: [searches for the page] CRI – this one here, crime. Have you committed crime?  
321 D2509 I am no crime.  
322 Callum Tulley: No crime.  
323 D2509 : No.  
324 Callum Tulley: You have no –  
325 D2509 : No. I am in lorry.  
326 Callum Tulley: You came in a lorry.  
327 D2509 Yes.  
328 Callum Tulley: That is your only crime?  
329 D2509 : Yes. Because they – because man – one man [presses a first to his neck and  
330 shoulder] fight me.
