- 820 **Callum Tulley:** He tried to take my keys.
- **Yan Paschali:** He actually grabbed the keys in his hand.
- 822 Callum Tulley: No he was pulling at the key chain, like proper pulling at it. I was just, I
- 823 just put SRO'd it I didn't say, I just stated the facts and stated what happened. Then
- 824 that's it.
- 825 **Yan Paschali:** He said to me the key were loose and he was only having a joke the keys
- 826 were loose. I'm just saying what he said
- 827 Callum Tulley: I know, yeah.
- 828 Male Officer 1: he's got that thing on his [Inaudible]

- 829 Dave Webb: [Inaudible] that was ages ago, was he tugging on the chain?
- 830 Callum Tulley: yeah, he was pulling on my chain, my keys are on my chain, my key are
- in my pouch. What was he saying?
- 832 **Dave Webb:** Done the right thing though.
- 833 Callum Tulley: the wording that was used was that 'he grabbed your keys', so he was
- 834 saying 'I did not grab his keys'.
- 835 **Callum Tulley:** well that isn't what I wrote in the SRO anyway.
- 836 Yan Paschali: Its not about what you said
- 837 **Callum Tulley:** Oh right.
- 838 Yan Paschali: He doesn't actually know what you said, but he was told he grabbed an
- 839 officers keys.
- 840 **Callum Tulley:** but what was he saying about me?
- 841 **Yan Paschali:** [Inaudible]
- Male Officer 1: he shouldn't have grabbed your keys anyway.
- 843 **Callum Tulley:** [Inaudible] spice weren't he?
- 844 **Radio:** [Inaudible]
- Yan Paschali: [Inaudible] think he had a smoke before the restraint.
- Male Officer 1: well he's a little crack head. Yesterday, lunch time, D-wing I was
- covering a break, he was like [Inaudible], got medical up, he was like fuck off, took his
- spice joint off. Then in the afternoon [Inaudible] kicking off. He fucking [Inaudible] tried
- the camera, fucking elbowed him. He ran off.
- 850 **Yan Paschali:** He's like a little rat
- 851 Male Officer 1: Yeah he is.
- 852 Callum Tulley: [Inaudible] I heard, I was told, I don't know if its true cause its like
- 853 Chinese whispers infit but Dan Small was saying, but he gave the team a hard time, and
- I was, I suppose the smallest can be the toughest can't they, wiry.
- 855 **Male Officer 1:** and his shoes were in the way. [Inaudible] there is one outside
- 856 [Inaudible] there's one down [Inaudible]
- 857 Callum Tulley: you know what I mean I'm not –
- Yan Paschali: he's been wrapped up before [Inaudible]
- 859 Callum Tulley: I'm not saying he should have gone to the block I just had to put the
- report in to cover myself do you know what I mean.
- 861 Yan Paschali: Just be wary, I'm hoping he don't get put back out [Inaudible]
- 862 **Callum Tulley:** [Inaudible] did you put an SRO
- Yan Paschali: will do tomorrow morning, we recoded him on the camera. [Inaudible]
- we documented it [Inaudible]. There talking about shipping him out, staying down the
- 865 block and shipping him out.
- 866 **Callum Tulley:** Thinking about putting him back on association, fuck him [Inaudible]
- 867 Male Officer 1: I tell you what Saunders, when he reads that he's fucking shit scared
- 868 [inaudible] another person getting out. He'll go ' I want him out' and he'll do everything
- 869 to get em out. I know that bloke he'll get him out.
- 870 **Dave Webb:** Cause he done it before we had even gone in the room. Saying he should
- 871 even be here.
- 872 **Callum Tulley:** Fair enough
- Yan Paschali: [Inaudible] don't be scared [Inaudible]
- 874 **Callum Tulley:** no I'm not.
- 875 Yan Paschali: Its stupid decision if he gets let out on association, just be mindful. If he
- 876 comes up to you just fucking floor him. Don't restrain him give him the hardest kick you
- 877 fucking can.
- 878 **Callum Tulley:** absolutely mate.
- 879 **Yan Paschali:** of all the paper work we are gonna put in, they know that there is a clear
- 880 risk to you. [Inaudible]
- 881 **Dave Webb:** [Inaudible]

- 882 **Callum Tulley:** yeah do you think he will recognise you?
- **Yan Paschali:** we'll find out in the morning.
- 884 **Callum Tulley:** he's not gonna, when he sees, when he's one to one with you he's not
- gonna say shit is he.
- 886 **Dave Webb:** [Inaudible]
- Yan Paschali: [Inaudible] I've seen some proper nutty behaviour
- 888 **Callum Tulley:** Really? Did he have a screw loose?
- Yan Paschali: He was fucking going 'I'm gonna do this to you, I'm gonna do this to
- 890 your family' did nothing then he started crying, started crying like a fucking baby. he's
- 891 mental he's metal.
- 892 **Callum Tulley:** What did you do to him?
- 893 Yan Paschali: I just had a chat. Didn't touch him
- 894 **Male Officer 1:** It's all that fucking spice shit. [Inaudible] gobing off. 895 **Callum Tulley:** shouldn't be going for peoples keys though should he.
- 896 **Yan Paschali:** no [Inaudible]
- 897 **Callum Tulley:** oh cheers for the heads up any way mate.
- 898 **Yan Paschali:** you in tomorrow?
- 899 [Inaudible cross-chatter]
- 900 **Callum Tulley:** yeah [Inaudible] she loved it mate.
- 901 **Male Officer 2:** making friends there.
- 902 Callum Tulley: what you mean?
- 903 **Male Officer 2:** don't know what I'm talking about.
- 904 **Callum Tulley:** are you talking about that polish guy, mate I don't know, lost count with
- 905 how many people I'm not friends with in this place. You talking about the little guy that
- 906 tried to take my keys? Oh yeah yeah, I heard the restraint went down well.
- 907 **Male Officer 2:** I heard it [Inaudible]
- 908 **Callum Tulley:** oh did you?
