CONTENT OF REPORT

I DCO B. Kosla-Rule was speaking with **D4291** outside the barber shop about drugs and the dangers about taking spice, I played 'dumb' and was asking questions with regards to how it takes place and how much it costs.

D4291 stated that there is a lot of money to be made and can be around £2000-3000 per day. **D4291** said that in prison for one cigarette with Spice inside you swap it for a packet of cigarettes, but in detention for one cigarette with Spice in it costs £10.00 per one. I then said 'it must be hard to get it inside a detention centre' **D4291** stated not really and then whispered in my ear 'it could be one of your friends' I believe him to be saying a colleague. I asked **D4291** if he gave it out free for people to try it before they brought it and he said he does not when he used to sell it he would try it himself to see if it was a bad batch or a good batch before selling it on. **D4291** then spoke about mobile phones and how he used to have two officers in prison that would bring in I phones and he would pay them £1000.00. **D4291** did not ask me to bring anything in for him but if he did I ask I already made it clear that I would never do that. **D4291** said he would never ask me.

<p>On the 21/01/2016 a member of staff was talking with D4291 regarding the dangers of NPS.</p> <p>D4291 said that there is a lot of money to be made and it can be around £2000 to £3000 per day. He stated that in prison one NPS cigarette would be exchanged for a packet of cigarettes but in Detention one cigarette containing NPS costs £10. When the staff member asked if it was hard to get it into the Centre he whispered "Not really, it could be one of your friends" which the staff member took to mean a colleague.</p> <p>D4291 was asked if he gave some of the NPS away for free for others to try before they brought it. He said he didn't when he used to sell it. He tried it first to see if it was a good or bad batch before selling it on.</p> <p>D4291 claimed that when he was in Prison he paid two officers £1000 each to smuggle him in an iPhone.</p>
