- 36 **Steve Loughton:** [Inaudible]. I don't know [inaudible] I'm trying to ask you, but you are
- being awkward and not telling me. We don't need [inaudible] but I need to know you are not
- 38 going to go [inaudible] on the surgery and cause trouble on the wing.
- 39 **Unknown Detainee:** [Inaudible]. I don't even want to look at that guy.
- 40 **Steve Loughton:** I'll do what I need to do. I'm not having you telling me what I have got to
- 41 do and when I've got to do. Because I've had all that with you. All I do is help you out and I
- 42 get nothing back. So I'll be looking at the cameras and then I'll find out what we have got to
- do with you. Alright? I'll have an officer out here so pack your stuff.
- 44 **Unknown Detainee**: [Inaudible]. I'm pissed off.
- 45 **Steve Loughton**: I'm pissed off myself, if I'm honest.
- 46 Unknown Detainee: Really? At least you get to go home, don't you? Do you get to go
- 47 home?
- 48 **Steve Loughton:** I do get to go home. But why is that -?

- 49 **Unknown Detainee**: [Inaudible] Your situation is not the same as mine or any other

- 75 **Callum Tulley:** [Inaudible] 8:30 in the morning, right?
- 76 **Male Officer 1:** Complete arsehole.

- here. I've made a change. Everything is cool. I don't speak to people like that, I don't even
- talk to officers like that [inaudible] not even once [inaudible]. Don't speak to me like that
- 268 [inaudible]. Mandem are trying to hold onto my hand Callum, I swear I am not lying to you, I
- swear even other people couldn't believe it, this Chris guy, this [inaudible], I don't know

- 306 D368 (Detainee): [Inaudible], you know, similar things like this just now, there you go, you
- 307 got it perfect. [Inaudible]
- 308 Callum Tulley: Yeah.
- 309 D368 (Detainee): [Inaudible]. Listen. You deal with people that have got a similar problem
- 310 to mine, or the same problem to mine -
- 311 Callum Tulley: Do you want to get out again or do you want to stay in Brook House?
- 312 D368 (Detainee): What, do I want to get out of detention or do I want to go to a different
- 313 detention centre?
- 314 Callum Tulley: No, do you want to get released?
- 315 **D368 (Detainee):** Yeah, of course, [inaudible].
- 316 **Callum Tulley:** But obviously, there's a time when you would have rather stayed here.
- 317 **D368 (Detainee):** What?
- 318 Callum Tulley: There was a time, when like you said, you would have rather stayed in Brook
- 319 House.
- 320 D368 (Detainee): Yeah, of course, I knew exactly what you meant, but the only thing is like
- 321 I should word it better but I do want to come out, obviously, but even then Callum, I'm not
- 322 going to lie to you, I am a human being, I do like freedom just as much as... But, I was at a
- 323 point in my life when I turned things around and I started to think like a chess player, four
- 324 moves ahead. Should I just be content and happy because I've got given a freedom, but
- that freedom is just going to jeopardize everything else and make me get back to square one,
- 326 I might as well just stay put until a better solution can be found. That was my outlook on
- things, that was were I was, or should I just be like[inaudible] and then get out. First two,
- 328 three days, maybe a week, and then, you know, back to square one, same predicament,
- 329 nothing changed, they're same, back to the same cycle, same square one. [Inaudible] Until
- they find a plausible solution that both sides can come to agreement on... I don't want to stay
- 331 here, bruv.
- 332 **Callum Tulley:** Have you got a solicitor working on your case?
- 333 D368 (Detainee): [Inaudible]. One minute I've got one [inaudible] then they leave. At one
- 334 point I did. I'm still entitled to it.
- 335 **Callum Tulley:** Who is your solicitor?
- 336 D368 (Detainee): Duncan and Lewis.
- 337 **Callum Tulley:** What the name because I know a few of them.
- 338 **D368 (Detainee):** Yeah, Dennis.
- 339 **Callum Tulley:** Denise?
- 340 **D368 (Detainee):** Dennis.

- 354 **Callum Tulley:** Oh, really?
- 355 **D368** (**Detainee**): Yeah, I left one prison, and some of my clothes [inaudible].
- 356 **Callum Tulley:** How did you lose your teeth?
- 357 D368 (Detainee): I had them out -
- 358 **Callum Tulley:** No, your actual teeth.
- 359 D368 (Detainee): I had an accident. I had a fight. And before you know it, the infection had
- 360 them.
- 361 **Callum Tulley:** Ah I see, I see what you are saying. That is mad, man, you just got to keep
- 362 your head up, mate, do you know what I mean? I know its so easy for me to say, but I've
- got to say, I've got to tell you, you've got to keep your head up mate.
- 364 D368 (Detainee): No, it's nice, it's nice.
- 365 **Callum Tulley:** We only want people only want we only want the best for you, mate, you
- know, it's not nice seeing you off your tits on spice.
- 367 **D368** (**Detainee**): I know it comes from the right place, when it's coming from someone like
- 368 yourself, I mean I'll can't say the same about many but [inaudible]. Things like, I thought I'd
- 369 come back to this place, put myself together, small steps, go gym, go welfare. I went to the
- 370 gym, like you were saying, just to see [inaudible]. I went across to go welfare. There was a
- 371 queue from here to Timbuktu.
- 372 **Callum Tulley:** I believe it.
- 373 D368 (Detainee): There is more people in the wings, going back to their wings, sitting on
- their wings and waiting and then coming back there. Whoever is that orderly thing thinks he
- 375 can just run his lot, you know? His countrymen or whatever [inaudible]. Another four or five
- people in front, and after that man there, it is my turn and I will get to you [inaudible]. So we
- 377 left it to that. Two other guys come to talk to him in his language and he went 'yeah, yeah,
- 378 next, next, no worries'. I went 'they weren't even there'. 'No, they come from before and
- then they left' 'Hold on, you said to me that I left, so why did you let them next?' So Gus [?]
- 380 set again back to square one innit. I just walked off.
- 381 **Callum Tulley:** Good move, mate. Good move.
- 382 **D368** (**Detainee**): What about yourself, mate, are you alright?
- 383 **Callum Tulley:** I'm all right, mate, really. Just like you mate, passing the time, getting by
- 384 every day, same stuff different day.
- 385 **D368 (Detainee):** Yeah, yeah, [inaudible].
- 386 **Callum Tulley:** Just keep myself to myself.
- 387 D368 (Detainee): Best way, that's the best way, that is the best way. I'll be surprised, you
- 388 know, when I was outside, certain people, even the girls, [inaudible] she come to me. I kept
- 389 myself to myself. Do you believe that?
- 390 **Callum Tulley:** Yeah, yeah.
- 391 D368 (Detainee): And the more someone come around me, even the girldem, the more I
- 392 push them away. It even got to a point when I was gonna [inaudible] with them. Two of them
- 393 together [inaudible] both of them. [Inaudible]
- 394 Callum Tulley: Yeah, yeah.
