Dave Aldis

Please describe the Incident details in full, confirming details of place of incident, time, date, names of all persons involved, witnesses, injuries sustained, first aid or healthcare provided, and details of which managers were informed of incident.

I DCM Dave Aldis was working a day shift at Brook house IRC on the 28/06/2017 as duty operations manager (Oscar 1). At the end of my shift at 2115 I handed over to the night Oscar 1 Ann Warrilow. I remained on site after being asked by my senior manager Dan Haughton to help with the Nigerian charter which was currently going out of discharge.

At this point there were only a small amount of detainee left to be discharged to Tascor. It came time for detainee **D2054** to be taken to meet with the escorts. I know **D2054** from a previous incident which happened earlier on in the day where he had self harmed by cutting his upper left arm with a razor blade and was now on constant watch all due to him not wanting to be removed from the country.

Due to knowing that he did not wish to go I assembled a team officers in full PPE to help with the removal if he refused to move. These officers were; DCOs Simmonds, Di-tella, Martin, Shadbolt and Murphy. I conducted a briefing on a body worn camera with these staff and the healthcare clinical lead Chrissy Williams, she had no concerns for us using force if necessary.

We then proceeded to room E/007, I opened the door and explained to **D2054** the situation and that I needed him to walk with me compliantly to discharge. **D2054** started crying at this point. I explained to **D2054** that if he didn't walk that I would have to use force as the last resort. **D2054** kept crying and not moving from his bed. I gave **D2054** a few more chances but he refused to acknowledge me. At this point I had no other option but to send the team in to remove **D2054** forcefully to ensure he was presented to Tascor so the move could go ahead.

The team entered and gained control of **D2054** quickly, he was resisting quite a lot and shouting out loud. Due to his resistance I authorised the use of hand cuffs and these were applied by the team. They then walked out of the room with the detainee under control and made their way to discharge. Throughout the move I asked healthcare if they were happy for the team to continue and they had no concerns.

When arrived into discharge the Tascor head escort placed his handcuff onto **D2054** so I could remove our hand cuffs, Tascor escorts also took over control of **D2054**'s arms so my team could stand down.

This concludes our part in this removal. Healthcare completed F213 and UOF paper work completed by the officers.
