- [Inaudible]. He's gone [inaudible]. He's [inaudible] goes down to 60 and then [inaudible].
- **Callum Tulley:** What's with the -- what's with the fitting?
- **Female Medical Staff 2:** It's because his brain doesn't know what's going on.
- **Unknown Male Speaker 4:** Is he, do you think it's the spice or [inaudible]?
- **Female Medical Staff 2:** I think he's taken something else.
- **Unknown Male Speaker 4:** I bet [inaudible].
- Female Medical Staff 2: Normally it's fine [inaudible]

- 653 **Unknown Female Speaker 2:** [Inaudible] managed by now.
- 654 Female Medical Staff 2: Yeah, you normally have a manic episode and then you get up and
- 655 you're fine.
- 656 Unknown Male Speaker 4: [Inaudible] done it together and he does it all the time as well.
- 657 **Callum Tulley:** I'm going to have to re-position legs.
- 658 **Male Officer 6:** [Inaudible].
- 659 **Callum Tulley:** Hey? Oh yeah, shit. My legs are killing me.
- 660 Female Manager 1: It's alright, stand up mate. It's fine, we don't, we don't need to have so
- 661 many guys here.
- 662 **Callum Tulley:** It's only when he's fitting.
- **Female Manager 1:** It's only when we try to move him, he [inaudible].
- 664 Female Medial Staff 2: I was going to say, if you need to stretch just --
- **Female Manager 1:** It's all right, he's not really moving is he. it's only when he has a shake
- on that [inaudible].
- 667 **Female Medical Staff 2:** A shake on.
- **Female Manager 1:** For want of a better word.
- 669 **Male Officer 1:** Spice fit, [inaudible].
- 670 **Callum Tulley:** NPS, they call call it. Yeah I think so.
- 671 **Female Manager 1:** PS now.
- 672 **Callum Tulley:** Is it, oh really?
- 673 **Male Officer 1:** Yeah 'cos [inaudible].
- 674 **Callum Tulley:** What there's [inaudible]?
- 675 **Female Manager 1:** [Inaudible] substance, yeah.
- 676 **Callum Tulley:** All right.
- 677 **Female Manager 1:** They dropped the N.
- 678 **Callum Tulley:** What was the N for then?
- 679 **Female Medical Staff 2: D149** open your eyes, come on.
- **Female Manager 1:** Erm its gone. Sorry, my brains gone.
- **Callum Tulley:** Do you have no identifier for [inaudible]?
- **Female Manager 1:** No. Erm, do you known it's completely gone.
- **Unknown Male Speaker 4:** Doctor? Is that the doctor? Get them in.
- 684 Callum Tulley: Shall I get him in, yeah. Just maybe rush -- encourage them to go and stop
- 685 staring [inaudible]. [Leaves corridor and enters courtyard]. Closing now gentlemen, closing
- 686 now. Okay fellas, take it there. Cheers. Thanks lads, thanks. [Inaudible] doing?
- **Female Officer 2:** Have you checked behind there?
- 688 Callum Tulley: I haven't actually. Actually, no, not properly, no. Hey? No, you're right. There
- we go, no one's here. There was only about 20 out here.
- 690 **Female Officer 2:** [Inaudible].
- 691 Callum Tulley: Oh yeah, yeah, you're right. It wouldn't be the first time someone's hidden
- 692 behind that.
- 693 **Female Officer 2:** [Inaudible] triple check.
- 694 Callum Tulley: Yeah. This door really. [Goes back into corridor and ambulance team have
- 695 arrived].
- 696 **Unknown Male Speaker 5:** Is the courtyard clear?
- 697 **Callum Tulley:** Everything's clear, yeah.
- 698 **Unknown Male Speaker 5:** Is it locked up?

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- 699 Callum Tulley: Yeah.
- 700 Unknown Male Speaker 5: Cool.
- 701 **Female Medical Staff 2:** [Inaudible] any scissors?
- 702 **Callum Tulley:** Yeah, fellas, it's time to close now. Brook House, Brook House.
- 703 Female Manager 1: It's sad, innit [inaudible]. This kid is ppa years old. Why, they've got
- 704 nothing, nothing better to do here, you know.
- 705 [Inaudible cross-chatter].
- 706 **Female Manager 1:** Sorry?
- 707 **Female Medical Staff 2:** D149 his surname.
- 708 Male Ambulance Staff 1: [Inaudible] hello? [Inaudible].
- 709 Male Ambulance Staff 2: Right.
- 710 Male Ambulance Staff 1: [Inaudible].
- 711 Male Ambulance Staff 2: [Inaudible].
- 712 Male Ambulance Staff 1: Okay. We'll turn this off now. [Inaudible].
- 713 Male Ambulance Staff 2: [Inaudible].
- 714 **Male Ambulance Staff 1:** [Inaudible] can you get the trolley bed in. [Inaudible].
- 715 **Unknown Female Speaker 3:** [Inaudible] chair down.
- 716 **Male Ambulance 1:** He's going to have to lay.
- 717 **Unknown Female Speaker 3:** [Inaudible] the chair.
- 718 Male Ambulance Staff 1: Because if he fits. [Inaudible].
- 719 Female Medical Staff 2: He's been on and off for 45 minutes. He had [inaudible] for about
- 720 30 seconds.
- 721 **Male Ambulance Staff 1:** Okay.
- 722 **Female Medical Staff 2:** But he's been [inaudible].
- 723 **Male Ambulance Staff 1:** [Inaudible] like this?
- 724 **Female Medical Staff 2:** Yeah.
- 725 **Male Ambulance Staff 1:** I'll put a line, just in case. We've got a bit of a journey.
- 726 Female Medical Staff 2: Okay, do you want him a bit more to his hip or are you all right
- 727 there?
- 728 Male Ambulance Staff 1: To be honest I'm used to doing it on toilets and stairwell so he
- 729 should be all right.
- 730 Unknown Female Speaker 4: Keep going, back to your rooms please guys. Come on, how
- 731 would you like it if it was you lying there? It's not nice.
- 732 **Male Ambulance Staff 1:** [Inaudible].
- 733 **Female Medical Staff 2:** [Inaudible] times we warn them. [Inaudible].
- 734 Male Ambulance Staff 1: Yeah, see what happens [inaudible].
- 735 **Female Medical Staff 2:** His sats are better than [inaudible]. 73 [inaudible].
- 736 **Male Ambulance Staff 1:** Can you move him over your way a little bit more? That's perfect.
- 737 **Male Ambulance Staff 2:** [Inaudible] history of drugs?
- 738 **Female Medical Staff 2:** Spice.
- 739 Male Ambulance Staff 1: [Inaudible]. Yeah, okay, are you guys, is everyone alright to help?
- 740 **Callum Tulley:** Yeah, of course.
- 741 Male Ambulance Staff 1: [Inaudible], top tail around the bed.
- 742 **Callum Tulley:** Sorry mate, can you repeat that?
- 743 **Male Ambulance Staff 1:** Yeah, so we'll pull him over this way, to me.
- 744 Callum Tulley: Yeah.

- 745 Male Ambulance Staff 1: And then we'll get a bed down there behind, and top tail
- 746 [inaudible] on the bed. There's no elegant way of doing it.
- 747 **Callum Tulley:** Sure, sure.
- 748 **Female Medical Staff 2:** Otherwise [inaudible].
- 749 **Callum Tulley:** Is he going to be sat on his back?
- 750 **Female Medical Staff 2:** Yes. That's the best way of doing it.
- 751 **Callum Tulley:** Where do I lift him up from? Okay. Yeah, let's go, sure, yeah.
- 752 [Officers and medical staff lift D149 onto trolley bed]
- 753 **Female Medical Staff 2:** Do you want [inaudible] up a bit?
- 754 **Steve Loughton:** [Inaudible].
- 755 **Male Ambulance Staff 1:** What's that?
- 756 **Female Medical Staff 2:** He's just nearly walked into a sharp.
- 757 **Male Ambulance Staff 1:** [Inaudible].
- 758 **Female Medical Staff 2:** I had a sharp in my hand.
- 759 [Ambulance staff take D149 out of the corridor]
- 760 [Inaudible cross-chatter]
- 761 **Callum Tulley:** [Inaudible], all right, fellas. Is this fellow discharged?
- 762 **Unknown Male Speaker 6:** Is there anyone in there? Waiting room [inaudible].
- 763 **Dan Small:** Let me have a look. Callum hold this door for me.
- 764 Callum Tulley: Yeah, no worries. Just don't -- we're just going to check if there are any
- 765 detainees in the way and then quickly .
- 766 **Dan Small:** No.
- 767 Callum Tulley: No. What are you thinking Nath? Very funny Nathan. It's so unfair, these
- donuts. Don't touch them. Ohhhhhh. Do you think I can jump on one of them. All right, I willl.
- 769 Cheers mate.
- 770 **Male Manager 1:** Is there any risk [inaudible]? What's better for you?
- 771 Male Ambulance Staff 1: [Inaudible].
- 772 **Derek Murphy:** [Inaudible] paper clip [inaudible].
- 773 **Callum Tulley:** Paper clip.
- 774 **Male Manager 1:** Oh, you know, we've [inaudible].
- 775 **Male Officer 2:** [Inaudible].
- 776 Callum Tulley: No. Do you need a hand?
- 777 **Unknown Male Speaker 7:** [Inaudible] started.
- 778 Male Ambulance Staff 1: Are you alright to have someone in the truck [inaudible]
- 779 otherwise.
- 780 **Derek Murphy:** Pen?
- 781 Male Manager 1: Yeah [inaudible].
- 782 **Callum Tulley:** Pen.
- 783 **Derek Murphy:** Proper pen.
- 784 **Callum Tulley:** There you go, mate.
- 785 Male Ambulance 1: Have you got some documents that you can print out for me, the
- 786 details, anything you got on him?
- 787 **Male Manager 1:** I've got a picture.
- 788 Male Ambulance Staff 1: Have you got the names and [inaudible].
- 789 **Male Officer 2:** [Inaudible] names, date of birth [inaudible].
- 790 **Derek Murphy:** [Inaudible].

791 [Inaudible cross-chatter] 792 Male Ambulance Staff 1: All right, just enough to get him booked in [inaudible]. How long 793 has he been here with you guys? Has it been a while? 794 Male Manager 1: [Inaudible] months [inaudible]. 795 Male Ambulance Staff 1: We've got [inaudible]. 796 **Unknown Male Speaker 7:** [Inaudible]. 797 Male Ambulance Staff 1: Yeah. 798 Unknown Male Speaker 7: [Inaudible]. 799 Male Manager 1: What are you doing? 800 Unknown Male Speaker 7: Overseeing [inaudible]. 801 Male Manager 1: Oh now you're overseeing, are you? 802 Unknown Male Speaker 7: Where do you think I've been? 803 Derek Murphy: Okay. What time you want me to [inaudible]? 804 Male Ambulance Staff 1: [Inaudible], but once we are in the back [inaudible]. 805 Derek Murphy: Okay. 806 Callum Tulley: I'm going on my break. Oh, God no, I need to go up to visits, back to visits. 807 Male Manager 1: Watch out, watch out. 808 Callum Tulley: Oh sorry. Oh. 809 810 [END OF TRANSCRIPT] 811

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- 815 Callum Tulley: D149 the Kosovian detainee, very small, the one who tried to take my
- keys, do you remember? Very small guy, who speaks a bit like a road man. He was just -
  Male Officer 1: Oh, I know who you mean.
- 818 Callum Tulley: Small, short, small guy.
- 819 Male Officer 1: Yeah, he was in the block.
- 820 **Callum Tulley:** Very shy, he just [inaudible].
- 821 Male Officer 1: Yeah.
- 822 **Callum Tulley:** I don't know, he was just gone. [Inaudible] don't really know how to describe
- 823 it, he was just -- you know, when you see someone on spice and they just like, they fit
- 824 obviously and then they come round. But you know you see those -- sometimes you see
- those people that are just like possessed, just like a man possessed he was like. I don't know
- 826 what was going on.
- 827 **Male Officer 1:** Was he unconscious?
- 828 Callum Tulley: He was, he was, he -- his behaviour like sort of covered the whole spectrum
- of people's reactions to spice. So sometimes he was like fitting, like manically, like manically
- fitting, other times he was just unconscious and not really -- being unresponsive. Other times
- he was just screaming, like he was awake and screaming. He was sick, he was frothing at the
- 832 mouth, he was -- I can't really name like any spice attack symptoms that you wouldn't see
- 833 from him, do you know what I mean?
- 834 Male Officer 1: And he is the only one? I heard three [inaudible].
- 835 Callum Tulley: There was, there was, D313 do you know D313, the sensitive/irrelevant guy?
- 836 **Male Officer 1:** Yeah. Yeah, yeah.
- 837 Callum Tulley: The Sensitive/Irrelevant He was like, he was stumbling around the place and he
- got taken to -- he wasn't, he wasn't having a spice attack like D149 was. He was
- 839 just, he was just stumbled to E-Wing really quickly. It was just about -- he was just like -- as
- 840 if he was rushing, as if he had just snorted a load of Miaow or something, and he got
- 841 searched. And then there's this other guy, this guy come from Columbia, and he was like --
- 842 he just appeared, I don't even know if he was on spice, he just looked well drunk or well
- stoned, I don't know which one. But he went to E wing as well, because he was losing his balance and that, but the main focus was on **D149** and the NHS came and the paramedics,
- paramedics came and put a defibrillator, I think they put a defibrillator on him. I don't know
- what these things are, but they stuck two things on him, I think.
- 847 **Male Officer 1:** Yeah.
- 848 **Callum Tulley:** Yeah. I think so anyway.
- 849 **Male Officer 1:** Did they use it?
- 850 Callum Tulley: Actually, I don't know if they used it. I'm just trying to remember. They
- 851 injected something into him, that's for sure. Injected something into him, I don't know what
- and then he was wheeled out on the stretcher, and then I just seen him go out the window
- now on the ambulance. How are they getting in?
- 854 **Male Officer 1:** Waste of fucking resources.
- 855 **Callum Tulley:** What do you mean?
- 856 Male Officer 1: You know how much is it going to fucking cost for them to come here, to
- 857 have treatment on the NHS, hospital. When they could have gone to someone else waiting for

- 858 an ambulance now, and yes it adds up, it's a knock on effect innit. Another one in the queue
- 859 for A&E, another bed, I don't know.
- 860 **Callum Tulley:** What do you think the answer is?
- Male Officer 1: Unfortunately, that's how it is. [Inaudible] it's all money.
- 862 **Callum Tulley:** So how did you -- how do you reckon it's getting in?
- 863 Male Officer 1: What do you reckon?
- 864 **Callum Tulley:** I don't know.
- 865 **Male Officer 1:** Visits.
- 866 **Callum Tulley:** We're just sitting here now watching these guys, and like the cameras are so
- 867 well-positioned, and the checks, the patrols you do within visits are so regular. I find it hard
- 868 to believe that obviously, some will slip through, but I find it hard to believe that just the
- scale, just the shear amount that's getting through is coming from visits.
- 870 **Male Officer 1:** Officer?
- 871 **Callum Tulley:** I don't know, if I knew that, if I knew the answer to that question.
- 872 **Male Officer 1:** I'm bored as fuck. I'm hungry, you know.
- 873 Callum Tulley: Yeah, you can say, do you want to go and get some? If you wanna stretch
- 874 your legs if you want to [inaudible], I don't want it. You might not even want it yourself
- 875 [inaudible].
